








Overall, 18,691 Jewish immigrants came to Israel in 2012 according to an annual aliyah analysis by the Jewish Agency for Israel. These include:

Friends, this Gospel that we have received, that we are so thankful for. We are so thankful that the Messenger of this hour didn't compromise. What if he had accepted money for example, what if he had accepted popularity. You talk about someone who could have had it. He could have had all of that, but he would not compromise. He stayed true and even when people began to misunderstand and make accusations; he stayed absolutely true to his calling right from the beginning and years later. And that to me is preaching the gospel to every creature – living the gospel.

We may not be a preacher behind the pulpit but we are living a Gospel. So I want to come to one of the earlier Messages and he reads these same Scriptures and he says, this Message that was read to us this morning, we would call it "The Great Commission" for it was the last commission our Lord gave His disciples 'to go to all the world and preach this glorious gospel – good tidings of the resurrection for all the world for a witness and then He would return and that signs and wonders would accompany this message that was to be preached.

Preaching is not just vocalising. Preaching is not just saying some words. Preaching is a life that is lived. You are preaching. You preached this last week – maybe preached to others that I may never speak to, or these other ministers may never speak to. But you preached to them, because the Prophet said to them – and I want you to stay very attentive this morning. I have a distance to go. He said that preaching is demonstrating. Demonstrating is actually fixing something that is physically lived out. That's preaching, preaching the gospel.

You may say that there are signs and wonders and all of these things and healings and so on. That accompanies it. The main power is that you have been changed from a person of darkness to a person of light. You have become the children of light. Not of the night but of the day. That is the gospel, and the fact that you have lived every day and you walked the streets and you were in the stores and even more, you may think, 'Oh if I could only speak,' you are speaking louder than words. Your life is declaring it. Amen. Also in God's Provided Healing for this generation, he said, 'Every time a revival breaks out, any time in the Bible history or in the world's history, signs and wonders have accompanied the revival, God is in the camp.

I want to say, if these were some of my last words to this congregation, 'We should never come without any expectation of something to happen in the service. Any service expecting to see the hand of God. God is in the Camp. Hallelujah! And when there's illness, when there's trouble and when there's financial

difficulties or any kind of difficulties, God is in the Camp. And for those who know they have a need of deliverance, don't expect to walk out with it, month in and month out, but expect to be delivered from it..

But one of the most important things is when you have a spiritual need; it is so in the Scripture. People ask sometimes why we don't see signs and wonders and miracles. And often the people have not reached the point of desperation where they acknowledge – and I think of the man, the demon possessed one in the Gadarenes. And Jesus said, 'What is your name?' He said, 'Legion' which is a thousand. Now, here's one, I don't know if he had a thousand demons or not, but he was a wild man, a madman amongst the tombs, but God gave him sufficient reprieve to cry out "Jesus". He gave him sufficient space.

I find that so many people are bound by one thing or another, maybe complexes or... Hey, there's nobody here that is immune to demon activity. It comes and bothers you. It comes and torments in your mind. It torments some people in their sleep. It torments people and he is a tormentor. Some people have fear. Some people are bound by all kinds of things. You need to be free from that. Don't come to church packing it and go out expecting to pack it. You need to be free from that. Hallelujah!

And when we come to church, we're just saying, Satan has been on my case this week. I'm coming to church and I'm in expectation. Either the preacher is going to say something or somebody's going to pray a prayer that I don't even know about, but God is going to work in His body and I'm going to walk out a free person. And then you start seeing something different because people start coming with faith and expectation and God will pull it out of the preacher. God will pull it out of somebody who is praying.

And then you come to the next Service and you can rejoice at the next meeting. You sing different. You sing, GOD rich in mercy! Hallelujah! I just got delivered, Glory to God. This is a different meeting! God is in the Camp! Don't forget that, friends. That is what this church is here for. That's what this building is here for. Amen! Hallelujah! The Bible said, ***Then opened He their understanding.*** This was after the resurrection He opened their understanding that they might understand the Scriptures and said unto them, 'Thus it is written and thus it behooved Christ to suffer and to rise from the dead the third day that repentance

and remission of sins be preached in His name among all nations, beginning at Jerusalem.

The Apostle Paul said, for our gospel came not to you only, but in power and the Holy Ghost and in much assurance as you know what manner of men we were among you for your sake. So the gospel has come to you. It should give you such assurance. Hallelujah! You don't even have to sic yourself up. You don't have to even build yourself up. You'll be inspired by the Holy Spirit, not tomorrow, not next week, this day, this service. Hallelujah! If you expect a good service, that is what you'll get. If you expect something to penetrate you, do something and build you up in the holy faith and maybe not just for yourself, it might be for your family; it might be for a husband for a wife or a wife to her husband or whatever more.

Or to affect – I was thinking very much of the school and right from the Principal and down to the teachers. Do you know why the school was built? We didn't build a building to have a nice building for you children. We built a school with an atmosphere and have Holy Ghost teachers and young men and women come out of the school, who continue to preach the gospel and their lives changed. Transformed young men and women full of the Holy Ghost who preaches the Gospel every day. And this Gospel is with Power. And the first thing you experience is the Power to change you from an ordinary average person into one full of the Holy Spirit.

That is preaching as you walk down the street, preaching as you go in the malls and shop. You are preaching all the time. Your life is preaching. Hallelujah! For the Kingdom of God is not in word but in Power, The Kingdom of God. So the preaching of the Word is the manifestation of the Power of God. And the Manifestation – now, don't think it is just praying for the sick, because that was the beginning. Ah, I will get to it in a few moments. And the life of Jesus Christ was the very thoughts of God being lived out. The very life of Jesus, what He did and what He spoke was God's thoughts coming down to earth and being spoken and heard. Amen.

And I may be asking for some participation in a moment. I'm expecting this Service to be somewhat different. And the Angel speaking, announcing the birth of Jesus Christ, **And she shall bring forth a son and thou shalt call His name Jesus for He shall save His people from their sins.** That's why He was called Jesus, because even the word, Jehovah Saviour, Jesus, **for He shall save His people from their sins.** The name of Jesus is spoken, I would say, millions upon millions of times a day, but what God hears, **for He shall save His people from their sins.**

And a prophet comes and says, 'The only sin is unbelief. The only sin, which was the first sin, and that's the only sin, that's unbelief. All these other things in the life you see that the people are living, that's the attributes of unbelief. But there has to be a power to deliver us from unbelief and when the name

of Jesus is spoken or heard, all God knows – **HE shall save His people from their sins.** I want the congregation to say those words: **HE shall save His people from their sins.** Once again, all together – **HE shall save His people from their sins.** Now, I am going to ask you at different times, when I say the name of Jesus, you shall say, **HE shall save His people from their sins.** Hallelujah! JESUS! [And the congregation replied] **HE shall save His people from their sins.** Good! This isn't the rosary. This is the TRUTH! **He shall save His people from unbelief.** **HE shall save His people from their sins!**

There were men who needed healing. Blind men, lepers, and they said, 'Jesus, thou son of David, God hears and He shall save His people from unbelief' and they were given faith to be delivered and they received their sight and were healed by God. Hallelujah! By the name of JESUS! **HE shall save His people from their sins.** You are going to hear me saying it plenty of times and I am going to expect you to be saying it some of these times. **Thou shalt call His name Jesus.** Every time that name is called, God hears a call, for He knows the meaning, for the meaning came out of the mind of GOD, sending an Angel down – and she shall have a Son and thou shalt call His name JESUS – And God's thought was **He shall save His people from their sins** that is my tool – this is my Son. This is the instrument, and through Him, people will come to believe! Hallelujah!


And through Him, I will turn around what happened in Eden, and this is the second Adam. He shall not fall like the first Adam. He will not compromise. He will not surrender. And He will take captive the flesh and take it to the cross and He shall rise again out of the tomb. He shall save His people from unbelief. Hallelujah! That's why I don't care what your need may be, what your complex might be, what your physical need might be. He's greater than that! Whatever doubts you might have. Vision For Indonesia



He Will Make A Way ☐

In follow up to the testimony of how the Word of God is spreading in Indonesia, the world's 4th largest nation, we are continuing with the testimony of our dear Sister Mia.

In last month's issue of the BNL, a report was given of how the Lord wondrously provided airtime for Brother Itok to preach the last days message in Indonesia and a few amazing testimonies that came as a result.

Given the success and fruits of this outreach in Brother Itok's home city of Medan, his vision and burden grew to expand to the other main cities of Jakarta, Surabaya and Bandung. This was of course a bold vision and desire as there was no available airtime or funds by which to pay. Nevertheless, Brother Itok spoke by faith and believed God would make a way.

The confirmation to this burden and vision came in an amazing way. In the previous article it was told of remarkably the Lord had provided airtime and also the "seed money" for the broadcast that is now being aired in the city of Bandung.

This testimony is to praise God for how the first offering in support of the Bandung radio broadcast was given by our dear Sister Mia Sitangang. It is an incredible account of one sister's faith, her determination and great perseverance. Sister Mia is an example to us all of what God can do through one who is willing to trust the Lord.

As mentioned in the previous report, Sister Mia is a paraplegic who was confined to a wheelchair, the result of a tragic car accident some 20 years ago. If this tragedy was not enough, a mere six years after her accident, Sister Mia's husband also passed away leaving her to raise her three small children.



Alone and destitute, she started a simple pay-phone business for long distance calls. This business is popular in developing countries where few homes are connected by telephone. With the advent of wireless technology and cell phones though, this business and the small income it provided, eventually dried up and was no longer able to meet Sister Mia's needs.

Undeterred and determined to provide for her family, Sister Mia did not let her handicap hinder her. She had to get out – but to do that, she needed help. She hired a young Muslim man to lift her out of her bed and to carry her into her small vehicle. He would then drive her to some residential areas where she was carried and placed in her wheelchair. Then her Muslim helper would push her from door to door as Sister Mia tried selling drinking water she had bottled. Amazingly, the Lord blessed this simple business and provided our Sister with enough to live from.

It was at special meetings in December 2012 that Sister Mia heard Brother of Itok's vision and burden and how he wanted to reach the people of her city, Bandung, by radio broadcast. Moved by the Spirit of God to respond and do what she could, Sister Mia then began saving money from her meager income of selling water door to door. As she began to "invest" for the Kingdom of God, Sister Mia's business also began to prosper. The Lord was honoring her faith and commitment.

In just a few months, Sister Mia presented an amazing gift of 5 million Rupiah (equivalent to \$500 USD) to help start the radio broadcast in her city of Bandung! To appreciate this incredible sacrifice and the blessing of God upon our Sister, one must understand that the average mean salary per month in Indonesia is only \$150 – but that the majority live on less than that per month.

Sister Mia had taken God at His Word and He abundantly confirmed it. May this testimony of our dear Sister serve to inspire and encourage you too in the state you find yourself in? We know that no mountain is too high, no valley too wide, and no sea too deep that the grace and provision of our Lord cannot overcome.

Kenya, Ethiopia Mission Trip

23rd April to 22nd May

First Ethiopian Baptized in Nairobi

ACTS 8:27 † And he arose and went: and, **behold, a man of Ethiopia...**

39 † And when they were come up out of the water, *the Spirit of the Lord caught away Philip, that the eunuch saw him no more: and he went on his way rejoicing.*

Baptizing the first Ethiopian in Nairobi, Kenya; his name is John



On Friday, 26th April we met with Bro John in the afternoon which was on the same day we arrived in Nairobi. I spoke with him and we had a wonderful time together with him on the experiences he has had with Christ before. He is a Lawyer

by profession and was a part time Lecturer at one of the Universities in Ethiopia as well as an active member and evangelist of a Christian church there. Due to his exposure to the public, the government suspected him to be against the Federal Republic which led to his imprisonment.

After several years of imprisonment, he was taken out shot and left somewhere to die. Due to his Faith in God, he testifies that he spent 5 days without any food nor any help save for the divine intervention of God. God fed him daily and healed him miraculously.

It was after this experience that he fled to Kenya for his life as a refugee. However, God had other plans for him. It was in Kenya where he met an evangelist that shared the same bible he believed with him BUT now in the Light of the Message of the Hour.

On Sunday 28th, I felt led of the Holy spirit to phone Bro John and find out if he was now ready to make his calling & Election sure (II PETER 1:10) by accepting Jesus Christ in true Christian Baptism. He replied in these words..” **Brother, I am willing anytime, if you that is**

delaying me.” Surely I felt the power of God moving me to remind me Acts 8:36...”**what doth hinder me to be baptized?**”

For, I had not realized I was the one like Phillip delaying this man. (Acts 8:27) ...We arranged and straight away I took him to the waters of Baptism in the Name of the Lord Jesus Christ. My wife, Pastor Wycliff, Bro Mburu Paul my friend and co-worker as well as several other brethren were around to witness this event.

A brother, Jason Voroga burst into a Word of prophecy in these words:-

“Bro Bus”, I saw in a vision last night. **Bro John came & told me that he has been baptized today!** And thus I say, **It was then that I saw a DOOR to Ethiopia already OPENED for you.**”

It was after the baptism of John that we flew to Addis Ababa on Wednesday 1st May. In all missions I have taken before, this being by air was the fastest journey which being impossible God made it possible thus the Spirit of the Lord caught me away to Ethiopia where yet more miracles happened...

Arrival in Ethiopia

We booked for the cheapest ticket on Ethiopia Airlines which was a night one. Left from Jomo Kenyatta airport on Wednesday at 5:40 am and arrived at Bole international airport in Addis Ababa, at 7:45 am of the same day.

Indeed, a door had been opened for us to this country. When we arrived in Addis, the next question was **What next?!**

No sooner had we asked ourselves this Question than someone arrived from the blue to pick us up. It was

Bro. Gideon who I had spoken to earlier. He is a believer of the Message of the Hour from Zimbabwe whose Pastor is Bro Godwin Chitsinde of Spoken Word Ministries in Belvedere, Harare.

Of many people I have met in the message, Bro. Gideon truly displayed a wonderful Christian character any one should expect from a “believer” in not only receiving us but also extending to us any support and attention we needed in the time we spent in the nation of Ethiopia. We for a few hours rested at his home and then we

were headed for the guest house which he helped find for us since he has spent several years in the country of Ethiopia. Bro Gideon is a diplomat working with AU which initially was referred to as O.A.U.

Connection with Mr Kumasa Kajela

Soon after we arrived in Addis Ababa, we started making contacts with several people letting them know what the Lord has done in our day. It should be noted that the biggest percentage of the inhabitants in the country do not speak nor understand the English Language.

One will have to use sign language and/or have an interpreter while speaking to the Ethiopians. Just a few people can be found to understand or speak English. By the grace of God however, John the refugee had given me his brother's phone number.

On phoning Mr Kumasa Kajela, I realized he is a teacher and lives over 100 kms away from Addis Ababa the capital at the place called Tulu Bolo. I informed him on the news, the good news I had for him and that I am a visitor in his country. Without hesitation, Mr Kumasa

told me he will be travelling to Addis Ababa to come and meet us the following morning.

On the morning of 4th May Saturday, Kumasa arrived at our guest house in Addis. My wife Sis Rebecca and I warmly welcomed him and I straight away started unfolding the good news I had brought for him. During this time, I did not know what my wife was doing but she excused herself to the bathroom only to find out later she was praying for God to guide my lips. Later after about an hour, she decided to rest on the bed as I continued to share with Mr Kumasa.

I made it clear to Mr Kumasa that we are not a denomination, nor do we intend to make one. I explained to

him that "the Lord commissioned us to go in the whole world and preach the gospel to every creature, he that **believeth and is baptized** shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned." (Mark 16:15-16)

I further told him that "this believing doesn't mean to join a church but it means to accept God's revealed Word of the Hour, which is His body made flesh in our day." After enlightening him on the differences we have with the denominations and introducing him to the Light of our day, I asked him if he was now ready to accept Christ as his personal savior even to the waters of Baptism.

He answered that he was not ONLY ready himself but he wanted to call a friend of her's who lives in Addis to also come and hear this Message of the Hour. I asked him to do that after his own baptism.

Baptism of Mr Kumasa Kajela

We started looking for a place where I can conduct the baptism to no avail. It was after several failed attempts that we finally found a hotel which gave us access to their Jacuzzi. The manager of this Hotel was a "Christian" and thus her offer.

We paid over 250 ETB for the Jacuzzi in order to perform the baptism. After the baptism(photos above) Mr Kumasa was one

of the happiest man to having fulfilled what the bible requires of him to be part of the body of Jesus Christ..

God vindicated himself in this baptism in a way that while we were ready to go out for baptism, I awoke my wife and the first thing she told me that "Are we ready for baptism now?, I dreamt that we were going to baptize a brother who had believed." I answered her, oh yes, Mr Kumasa wants to be baptized right now.

After the baptism, Mr Kumasa right away got on the phone to call this lady friend of hers to hear this Message he had received.

Connection with Sister Judith

Ms Judith like her friend John is a nominal Christian professing Jesus. She spoke & understood English well as she has been in a relationship with a German man for a long time.

She was sleeping since she slept in a watch night prayer meeting and had called off all

programs on this Saturday 4th. But here came John's phone call which she confessed that she felt compelled to come meet me however much she felt tired and sleepy.

Quickly, she arranged to come and meet us to hear of the good news, the message of the hour. This to me was like Bible days back to reality. Wasn't it the same thing that Martha did when she received

the good news of resurrection from the master? For sure, Mary never waited. The bible says that

" As soon as she heard that, she arose quickly, and came unto him"

Situation of Ethiopia

Before we left Uganda, I had a zeal within me to go and stand like a in a corner somewhere on the streets of Addis Ababa and preach the Message of the Hour.

However, unlike many African countries I have been to. Ethiopia is one of its kind where about 1% of its population can speak or understand English. Their official language is Amharic which is used by over 30% of the total population. The Language spoken by a bigger population is Oromo. Apart from these, there are about 90 more languages in the country, just like other African States.

The scarcity of the English Language in this country is due to the efforts of the Ethiopians made to preserve their

culture, customs & traditions which started by resisting the first Italian invasion in 1896. Thus Ethiopia remains the only Non-colonized country in Africa. She resisted European power and thus resisted civilization which goes with the English Language for many years.

It is only of recent when some schools have started teaching English in schools . Furthermore, the Orthodox and Muslim religions have so much covered the country that the people's mind are consumed with this darkness of religion.

Some of us who are used to fresh tasty foods, it is the opposite in Ethiopia. Their foods are full of red pepper and ingredients un-agreeable to the East African way of cooking which as a

result, we were forced to cook for ourselves.

The people are not white nor black, they are so much close to the Arabs thus any White man or black man visiting the country will be recognized in a bit. They often think these people have money and the spirit of begging is on a high level in the country.

Given all the difficulties, people like me believe there's a bride in this country. Some one will hear, and some one will believe.

As you have already read and will be reading on other pages, just like our Lord Jesus Christ ...it's a calling of one by one.

in darkness. That the message of this day is calling us back to the True unadulterated Bible doctrines with a full understanding. Without even knowing that this was a Lutheran Church, I spoke bitterly against infant baptism. I asked the assembly if there was anyone who has never been baptized in the correct baptism and would like to be baptized. About 5 people raised their hands, at which moment the Pastor said he can no longer interpret my preaching.

He said they do not conduct such baptisms at their church. I left the pulpit but satisfied that "Someone heard the TRUTH." After all, the bible in Mark 16:16 specifies the two types of people.

But, the Work was done!

After the service, I saw Sister Judith seriously explaining this issue to one of the elders in this church. She later told me that She told the elder how that they did not REJECT ME, but God himself who was speaking to them.

In addition, he also accepted baptism in the Name of the Lord Jesus Christ. Due to the little time we had in the country and his limited schedule, we weren't able to do the baptism but we are arranging it for next time.

In fact, Bro Justus is ready to arrange for us some sessions wit the students at the air force school.
