




From the Editor's Desk:

It took us another two hours reach Mityana from Kampala using the Congo Road. I taught at Brother Leo Ruhwabwabu's church that evening. Most small towns and village churches almost never receive visits of preachers from other

countries and they really appreciated the contact. I used several of the congregation to create a time line of key Biblical characters as illustrations of types and patterns that apply to the Bride of todav.



UPDATED REPORT

THE BOUGAINVILLE TRIP. [13-27/05/2015]

This trip is especially towards my extended family in Buka (my sister and her husband), in Arawa (niece and her husband), and in Buin (nephew and his wife). The purpose is to introduce the Message of the Hour. Not only to them but also those that comes in contact with me as the Spirit leads. I arrived in Bougainville on the 13th May. During this evening I had a meeting with my sister, and briefed her about my trip.

(14/05) The first day we had fellowship, there were 6 adults and 7 kids. These people are Catholic by religion. During this meeting I shared on the love of God.

What had happened to us and that God has to come in the flesh and what is our response to that which is to give our lives to him and receive the new birth. We did have a great time in the Lord.

[15/05] During the second night I shared about Rom.4:1-25(13-25) telling the people that we must

have faith in the Lord, because what God said does not return void when we believe and know that God has the power to back it up.

During the day I met up with two brothers of the Oneness (united Pentecostals international) and had a conversation with them but found out that they do not recognise the prophet and that they must be a denomination. Pray for God's wisdom in dealing with people who say that we are of "one faith".

[16/05] I went to Arawa. It was a 4 hour journey. Praise the Lord I arrived safely. I briefly told my niece [Lydia Norg] of my purpose of coming and arranged for the fellowship nights.

[17/05] I gave copies of the Message of the hour to my niece and in her reading she came across the Trinity and she asked me about it. I shared to her about the Godhead and she understood what I was sharing. I believe that our Lord Jesus Christ will reveal more to her as she continues to read the sermons.

I had fellowship during the evening and shared about us being created in the image and the likeness of God and the importance of living in obedience and according to the Word of God. I also made arrangements to visit the Arawa Police Station and have

[18/05] I went and paid a visit to those behind

bars at the Arawa Police cells, I shared a message that it was not Gods plan for them to go through such a situation, but because of the fall such has happened. (20/05) Trip to Buin. I had the privilege to travel with my niece and husband to Buin and they went back to Arawa. The trip was a 2-3 hour drive. I spent the evening talking with my nephew and wife about my purpose of visit.

(21/05) I had fellowship in the evening with the family and the neighbours. We did have a blessed time of evening fellowship. Especially as I was sharing on being special in God's plan of creation.

(22/05) We did have our last fellowship with the family here at Buin. I shared on: "The Two Types of Builders"

(23/05) I was supposed to travel back to Arawa but it did not happen cause there was not any PMV available, so in the evening we saw a video of a 2011 Winter Camp of the Cloverdale called: "Fulfilling your Scripture"

It was really a blessing knowing that we are part of the Word and the Word came for the Word.

(24/05) We spent the whole day just at home till the evening, watching the End Times PowerPoint presentation and sing-along videos by Ron Millevo.

(25/05) I travelled back to Arawa by PMV. We did arrive safely in Arawa and it only took us 2hrs. We had fellowship at my niece's place. Those present was my niece's husband, his mother and a cousin brother.

(26/05) Back to Buka by PMV. It took us 4 hours to travel. The travel was really bumpy due to the rain, but praise the Lord we arrived safely. Bought my ticket to travel back home [Rabaul] tomorrow at 4pm

and arriving in Rabaul at 8am on Thursday morning. The trip back to Rabaul was calm and I'm now back with the family here in Rabaul.

A special thanks to all that have been praying for the trip and my encouragement is that we continue to pray for those that I came in contact with and continue the follow up with as we can see the opportunity there is to reach the Bougainville people with the Message of the Hour.

There were certain things that I did not do that should be done, such as the approaching the radio station to broadcast the Message of the Hour. I was unable at this time due to the Radio station covering the counting of votes in their elections.

By actually going and observing, I see that there is work to be done here at Totovel, the province, the regions and the nation of Papua New Guinea.

I have to follow up on the airing of the 30 mins Segments of Messages on our Radio Station here in East New Britain. Please continue to pray for us.



The Objectives:

- 1) Is to help the vulnerable children who are not able to pay for there dues/fees and school requirements.
- 2) Is to help the Female Christian children (MESSAGE BELIEVERS) to keep their HAIR long in order to stand for the FAITH. (There is a rule here that all school children both boys and girls to cut off their hair or keep

there hair linch short.)

- 3) Is to help the HIV/AIDS Victims especially those who are orphans.
- 4) And as a missionary and a pastor of a small church may help raise funds for my missionary trips.

Shalom Nursery And Primary School Started on Feb.2012 with a population of 150 children and a teaching staff of 10 Teachers minus the Non-Teaching Staff.And currently running with a population of 450 and 15 teachers.


It is located in Busia Uganda Western Division in Solo C Village and has lasted for 4 years and so far one of the good performing schools in the area.



My wife being A teacher she used to volunteer to teach and coach believers and neighbours children and when the number grew bigger they all encouraged us to start a school. Since we did not have structures for classes and dormitories we offered our own house and turned it to a school. At the moment we are squeezed in one bed room while the children are using all the the bed rooms, living room, dining room and kitchen as dormitories. Then we use the boys quarters and temporal structures as classes.

Due to the good performance of the school in the shortest time the school has attracted many children from Far and Near thus forcing us to make it a Day and Boarding School.But due to the limited accommodation and classes we have turned away many.

Now the School faces the challenge of lack of enough Structures, such as Dormitories, Beds, Classes, Latrines, Chairs and Scholastic materials.



Since the Schools aim is to help the vulnerable children it has been a challenge to raise salary payment for teachers because most of the parents are vulnerable/unable to afford even the payment of fees and the requirements yet our rates are the most minimal in the whole town. It is my humble prayer that God may open the way and we get funds so that we can support and help put up some structures to accommodate this big number of children that are struggling for a sustainable future.

May God bless you as the Lord will touch your hearts is my humble prayer.


Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ.

The reason we know this is that we were recently contacted by the Israeli Tour Company. They informed us that many other travel/tour companies are going to Israel this fall. This has resulted in a high demand for hotel space.

Consequently, we are under increased pressure to confirm our reservations with names of patrons in order to guarantee hotel rooms booked for this October – or else risk losing our accommodations.



As a courtesy to those who were/are considering joining us on tour this fall – but need more time to finalize plans, please take a moment to let us know your tentative plans as soon as you can, or at least by the end of the week. In this way the level of interest for the tour can be gauged and the tour company and hotels can be informed to hold our reservations.

Details for the tour again are, 12 nights – 11 Full days, 9 Days in Israel + 2 Days Jordan starting Wednesday, Oct. 7th through until Sunday morning, Oct. 18th.

Our tour begins at Shiloh, the ancient site of the Old Testament Tabernacle. This is in Samaria, the biblical heartland of Israel. From Shiloh we proceed to visit young Israelis who are claiming their rights by establishing new communities in the land God gave them. Once again we will be honored to have Rabbi Chaim Richman accompany us in Samaria who will also introduce us to his family with whom he is pictured.

We will tour many other biblical sites. Caesarea Philippi on the Coast; Mt Carmel, Nazareth and Tel Dan in the North not to mention many of the areas where Jesus ministered in and around the Galilee like Capernaum.



Vanuatu Relief - Cyclone Pam

Dear Brothers & Sisters in Christ;

This all began as a result of Cyclone Pam that hit the pacific nation of Vanuatu.

Brother Justin Lane Felt the burden to go to Vanuatu not long before he & his family were due to leave on an extensive holiday in the North Island, his passport had expired & the processing wasn't completed before he left Nelson so arrangements were made to have the passport deliverred to his Uncle up North in time for him to travel & The Lord made sure it all happened.

Brother Gavin Newport also felt the burden to go, but a whole series of events had to happen for this to be possible. The Lord took all of these things one by one & made it possible. This was to be how it was the whole time for both Justin & Myself from leaving to returning to Nelson & our home fellowship of Nelson Bible Believers. The Lord Jesus Christ had all things under His control.

We flew to Port Vila where we were met By Pastor William Frank along with 2 containers of tools, 2 ladders, a tent each and enough food thinking that we would have to 'rough it' not knowing what we would find when we got there. However, the first night we were there after Pastor William's fellowship had fed us and made us most welcome, we retired to our very

well appointed quest quarters, a few minutes after lying down a demon possessed dog started patrolling from just outside the back window to the front door & back several times, so it was obvious that we had stirred things up in the spirit realm. We got down in prayer, over the next few minutes the dog was deliverred & doubtless its owner as well. Pastor William was not surprised when we told him the next morning saying that voodoo is rife in Vanuatu.

Brother Adrian Gray had been in Vanuatu until shortly before we arrived and he recommended that we go to the village of Ipota on the island of Erromango, Pastor William was very patient as he drove us around on the wrong side of the road, buying the many things needed like chainsaw chains, replacement tips for the blade and many other things, as well as rice for Port Narvin

and Pastor Silas Nilwo's community at Ipota.

We flew out of Port Vila in a twin otter loaded with our supplies, over 220Kg of rice & 3 other passengers. We were in a thatched "guest" hut, the first visitors to use this since Cyclone PAM. Just prior to our arrival, a team of local school children had been put to work pulling on ropes to straighten all but the seaward-end of the leaning structure. We brought with us a 12 x 7.2m tarpaulin which was also fitted over the damaged thatched roof to protect us from any heavy rainfall.

We took a "banana-boat" trip around to Port Narvin. These boats are purpose-built, rugged, , and have an essential feature of a covered bow cargo hold, keeping bags of rice etc. dry from the often violently rough, breaking seas. We experienced up to 3m swells by estimation on our trip. While in Port Narvin we assessed the needs from food & replacement materials as well as quite a few tarps, it is expected to take

> 2 years for thatch to re-grow. One garden that we visited about 1.5km from the community it served, was strewn with wind-blown trees and branches, calling for clearing of the many "one-man



between villages.

This larger saw had a totally slogged-out rotary tip which Br.Gavin changed out with a new replacement tip, (as shown in the above photo) Thus it was left ready for free-hand rip-sawing of wind-blown coconut tree trunks – the delay being a long wait for a new chalk line to pre-mark the sawcuts. Use of this, already wind-felled local building material for reconstruction of damaged homes, building of replacement church etc is a good use of local resource, which would otherwise eventually rot and go to waste.

Along this line, Chief Silas owns family land from lpota all the way back into Williams Bay – a vast area with much wind-felled kauri now down on the ground, among other varieties of native timber and the much sought after sandalwood trees. There is no restriction on logging out wind-blown timber, which only lasts up to two years on the ground. The land between lpota & Williams Bay has been handed down to him, by inheritance, and naturally, he feels the responsibility to handle this huge dilemma appropriately & with Christ's coming so near, please pray for him in the decisions ahead

Chief Silas's community local Store, complete with 12 watt solar system, running lights and a large icebox, provides freezer space for locally hunted meat and fish etc... This system was not running properly on our arrival and Bro Justin was able to correct a number of issues including the solar regulator the roof mounted panels, and corrosion issues etc. Bro Justin was alerted to the problem by Sister Jacqueline that "the icecream is going soft can you help?" An abandoned charger that had been sitting out in the weather was checked over, and run up on a very clapped out portable generator that Bro Gavin got going again in the end as a result of both Pastor Silas & Gavin praying over it. With reduced output, and running hairily, for about a day or so during a rainy patch – then after this the rehashed solar panels and regulator

were able to take over. Sister Jacqueline was all smiles when she lifted the freezer lid & was met with the required cold front once more. All things that required a mechanical touch fell to Bro Gavin like cement mixer that hadn't gone for 2 years etc.... to all things electrical & electronic that fell to Bro Justin's God given genius & there were many like the radio installation for the airport, Pastor Silas's Cd player etc.......Jesus Christ allowed all things to work

The first ship coming to Erromango, finally left Vila on about Tuesday 21st April arriving overnight at Williams Bay, then on to Bongil, and South Reva. It broke down & was towed back to Vila with Ipota's rice shipment, so the rice we'd bought had to last. The Nilwo community were eating handsomely and feeding us very well with local wild pig kept fresh in the large solar-run freezer,

Although all hungry chickens had long stopped laying eggs, there was a supply of fresh fish, unsuspecting chickens, yam, taro, manyoak, island cabbages, and even some banana able to be salvaged from blow-downs We were also privileged to be treated to another highly sought after speciality dish of Erromango, Tuluk.

Yet while we ate very well with only one of the Nilwo communities 4 seaside and 3 hillside gardens being lost to the storm surged waters, many other families are still very dependent on Relief Supplies. We both experienced many instances of God's intervention in supply of material needs, personal physical healing, and arranging of circumstances beyond our control. Mathew 19v26 Even to delaying of flights and Air Vanuatu schedules in order to allow us to accomplish more for His Glory.

(We are impelled to say that these things are not by us - it's the Power of Christ Quickening our mortal bodies {Rom8v11}. Bro Justin was 'done' by the end of 2012, swamped in overwhelming depression, with exhausted energy, and hardly able to face odd-jobs at home, let alone abroad (which required additional planning, problem-solving and stamina). By a miraculous Deliverance from a fogged mind, with the accuser bringing on sensations and fears of heart-attack, Bro Justin experienced a Supernatural "Reconditioning", and life became a "new day".)

Perhaps a later edition of BNL will allow him to elaborate on this journey to Victory, for the Glory of our Risen Lord Jesus Christ.
