God is providing and we are printing 3000 Message books in Punjabi language every month and sending them out wherever we can. Also we are





The Apostle Paul launched his earliest evangelistic efforts by preaching in the Jewish synagogues of the cities he visited. But in Acts 16, all that was to change. God unveiled a new way to spread the message, totally outside of the Jewish church. Upon being divinely directed to go to Macedonia, Paul and Barnabas entered

"It was around 9pm and we were escorting Sis Yodit to the taxi. As Paul (Mburu) and I were wondering what the Lord would do next, little did we know He had prepared a soul not far from us to receive the Gospel. A harlot started following us along the way. We decided to stop and hear her out. She was up to her daily business. We introduced ourselves to her



as preachers of the Gospel of Christ and expressed our desire to meet her again while she is not under the influence of that kind of

him. He ran to a friend and asked to borrow
a change of clothes and came back after a
few minutes. He then asked us to baptize
him without delay as he really needed to
receive this Jesus Christ.

Philippi, the leading city of the area. But where to go? They ended up seated by the river, speaking to the women who worked there. A humble place to begin, but it led to the establishment of one of the greatest churches of the New Testament era. And it was all sparked by the conversion of one woman, and the deliverance of another. A woman called Lydia heard the message of her hour, was baptized and immediately offered her house to host the evangelists. It became the hub of the work in that city. Later, a demon possessed woman was delivered by the commandment of Paul. In this account, two women, divinely delivered by God, were at the very foundation of a great church.

When Brother Busobozi visited Ethiopia on his honeymoon in May 2013, he had almost no contacts. But early on, a woman named Sister Yodit received the Message, and was baptized. She quickly became a pillar in the new work, offering her time and resources, translating for street witnessing, and sharing the light she had received with others. This was followed a year later by one of the most exciting testimonies you will ever hear: the conversion and

As we were walking away from the hotel to find a restaurant for breakfast before heading home, Sister Yodit asked to take a photo of myself and Paul on one of the streets in Nazareth. As she took the photos. a woman came by, attracted to join in the photos. Her name, we found out later was Ruth and she was a wife of an evangelist who passed away six years prior We read and spoke of Ruth in the Bible, her character. her decision, her obedience, etc. I then told her that her great Boaz is the Lord Jesus Christ...she started crying. Later we spoke of many other scriptures which she firmly accepted. The only thing we could do was to immerse her in the name of her great Boazl



anointing. She consented. Sister Yodit was with us in the guesthouse to give us company as well as help interpret while we spoke to her. The woman's name was Marta, and she revealed that she became a double orphan many years before, and had turned to prostitution to help her situation. We spoke many things, but her answer was this: 'I have heard everything, but one thing I don't want to do is play with the blood of Jesus because I respect it so much, how shall I overcome this if I decide to follow Jesus now?'

You could see that she truly meant what she said. We had a very simple answer for her. I read Zechariah 4:6, and later Acts 2:38. It was past 8pm but she made two decisions which changed her entire life. She decided to RECANT prostitution and also decided to be baptized in the Name of Jesus Christ because she needed the blood to cleanse her past sins, and also to receive the Power of the Holy Ghost. We baptized her that very hour. Hallelujah!"

Brother Busobozi relates that Marta has been continuing on in her faith, coming around often, hungry for the Word, while Yodit is always available to help and translate. Like the demon possessed woman of Acts 16, Marta's conversion had left some of her former associates upset. One evening while sister Marta was being escorted to the taxi home, some men approached asking her why she was no longer available for business. She strongly rebuked them saying she had given her life to Jesus! Now she washes clothes for a living. In Ethiopia, prostitution is legal, and many young girls get forced into it by circumstance. But God can deliver!

Sister Marta is just one of many testimonies that have come out of Brother Busabozi's four trips to Ethiopia. At this time 15 have been baptized, and 9 of them live in the capital city, Addis Ababa. These young believers are hungry for the Word, and desire a church in their town. Also, a revival is sparking at the nearby Nazareth University, where young people are being touched by the Revelation of the Hour.

As the revival in Ethiopia grows, there are several immediate and pressing needs. One is the need for translation of the Message. The national language of Ethiopia is Amharic, and at this time only three

Sis Yodit had a friend whose Name is Bihailu who goes to Nazret/Adaama University. Behailu came to visit us, and invited us to visit him at the university. Paul, Yodit, and myself went. We really were wondering, could anything good come out of Nazareth? In the night, I dreamt that we would meet several university students and that we would speak with them. I shared it with my fellow soldiers in the morning as we were setting out for the day. Well, it really happened. We met and spoke with University students at a place where Sis Yodit had suggested we take coffee. It became a church, each of us was speaking with one in a certain corner. Several heard, and said they would hear again.

This will require his constant personal presence, so he is planning to relocate to Addis Ababa for up to six months. While there, he hopes to navigate the difficult legal maze to setting up a church. A building that could be both church and translation center would be ideal. Prices are expensive in Addis Ababa, and

the government suspicious of anything foreign. The Believers are searching for a building now, and the Lord's help will be needed to find just the right place. Pray for the success of the work in Ethiopia, and also that leadership will be raised up from among the new believers. There is much work to do in ministry and translation, but we continue to move forward as our Lord provides for His Elect in Ethiopia.

Latest Vanuatu Report

Cyclone Pam was the largest recorded storm to be ever recorded in the Pacific region. This category 5 cyclone skimmed the north of Vanuatu and had a direct hit on the South last month on the 12th of March.

A thank you to all the brethren for the Vanuatu Relief work.

Six weeks ago I had arranged to fly two ministers from New Caledonia to Port Vila in Vanuatu so that the local bi-lingual (French/English) ministers could meet them and edify them in the Word of God with a week of meetings. The meetings were scheduled for the 25th. The strategy was then to use the Vanuatu ministry to go to New Caledonia and help in furthering the message there. In between the planning and the upcoming meetings, the cyclone struck with vehemence.

To a westerner it is hard to understand that there are still nations that live with semi-subsistence economies - economies without electricity, phones, water reticulation and a roading system. But that is common in the south Pacific and Vanuatu in particular. When a cyclone strikes in the outer islands, you cannot go down to a supermarket, hop in a truck or even phone for help especially if the scarce cell phone towers have been damaged.

It took a week to hear from Bro William Frank in Port Vila because of the communications damage, but once he was able to get through it became very clear that many brethren in the islands had been severely affected. Bro William asked for whatever assistance could be given and the support from around the world was immediate and outstanding.

Our missionary account in NZ was initially made available to hold donations until the bank system in Vanuatu was back in action and by the grace of God thousands of dollars poured in from many nations.



On the 25th of March my wife and I flew into Port Vila. The brothers from New Caledonia had arrived and we still continued on with a week of meetings. But the Port Vila city that I knew so well was greatly changed. Trees had gone, houses blown apart but the people still had a smile on their faces.

The following day I chartered a plane to Ambrym Island and five of us arrived unannounced in Endou Village, the home of Pastor Mael Moses and his family and fellowship (pictured). They were overwhelmed to see us (Bro Jerry Sellers from the USA, Bro Pethuel Beru, Bro Willam Frank, Bro Andre Bole, and myself) and we had a time of surveying the damage

and working out a plan of relief. During that time a phone tower on Pentecost Island was restored and Bro Paul Hinge was able to be phoned and involved in the plans. All the top fruit-bearing canopy of the trees was gone and the root crops affected so that there was only 4 days of food left.

After working out a food budget with the sisters involved, we concluded that 100kgs of rice per family was needed for a period of 6 months in the northern islands of Pentecost, Ambae and Ambrym. At that time no communications from those on Erremongo in the deep South had arrived so we had to wait until Bro William could fly down a week later. In those northern islands we had to budget for about 110 families. It would be at least 6 months before nature could restore its fruits.

The next day we all flew back to Port Vila and went hunting down bulk rice supplies. We managed to find a storehouse that supplies the city shops with rice and other food items and negotiated with a Chinese merchant for a starter of five and a half tons. This cost about \$US7000 including freight charges and

was put aboard two ships (one pictured left) that sailed that evening. It was hectic day working our way through the obstacles but by the grace of God the ships got to the brethren and they went out in their boats to meet the ships and bring the bags of rice ashore. There are no wharves there.

During this time a lot of work had gone into

setting up a relief account in Port Vila at the ANZ Bank for receiving donations. Sister May Boe and Sister Emmanuelle Lulu are ANZ employees and did an outstanding work in setting this account up. Donations can now be sent





directly to the brethren in Port Vila. Sister May and Bro William Frank are the trustees and I hold directorship over the account. I totally trust these brethren and have known them for many years and know they will utilize the funds responsibly. All expenses are to be documented and made available for anybody to see.

As of today (15th April) a ton more of rice has been purchased and sent down to Erremongo. Bro' William flew down as planned and has surveyed what is needed. Also another 6 – 10 tons will be sent out as a second supply load to the northern islands. Over all, about 300 to 400 brethren are being looked after with the rice supplies that came from donations.

When we arrived back in NZ on the 3rd of April, we went straight to the Auckland Convention which was hosted by Bro Derrick Donaldson's fellowship. A meeting was held with a few brothers to work out what further assistance could be sent to Vanuatu.



The Seven Feasts of the Lord (Leviticus 23) - Review

This series will give you a detailed and clear overview to the wonderful truths contained in these Seven Feasts of the Lord in the light and revelation of the message of the hour.

These Seven Feasts of the Lord as kept by the Jews in the Old Testament during their agricultural harvest season were a prophecy of **Christ**, and the **Seven Gentile Church Ages**, and the **End Time Hour** that we are living in right now. They show the plan of redemption from the time of **Christ** (who is our true pass over lamb, and unleavened bread, and first fruits), to the feast of **Pentecost**, which are the **Seven Gentile church ages**, and to our time now when the last three feasts of **Trumpets**, **Atonement**, and **Tabernacles** are coming to pass in this day.

Six trumpets (of the Feast of Trumpets) began to sound under the first and second world wars and are even now still calling Jews back to their homeland of Israel (we have seen this take place in this age). But what are the Israelites been gathered for? They are being gathered for the purpose of recognising Christ which is their true **atonement**, which is revealed by the sounding of the Seventh Trumpet. Although the Trumpets are strictly for the Jews and not for the bride of Christ, the bride is also following this same pattern in parallel as we have also been called out from all denominations by the shout of the message to also recognise Christ (as revealed in the entirety of His word by the opening of the seven seals), He is also our Atonement, he is the Mighty God Unveiled to the Bride in this hour.

Brother Branham taught us that what the Seventh Trumpet is to the Jews, the Seventh Seal is to the Bride – it is to recognise Christ (the Atonement – Feast of Atonement). The Seventh Trumpet to the Jews is when they recognise Christ their true Atonement under the ministry of the two prophets (Moses and Elijah), and the Seventh Seal to the bride is also to recognise the revealing of the son of man (Christ) our true Atonement by the opening of the word in this hour under the message of our prophet William Branham. The same Boaz (Christ) is revealed to both Naomi (the Jews) and Ruth (the Gentiles) at the harvest time.

What the Feast of **Trumpets**, **Atonement**, and **Tabernacles** is to the Jews; the **Shout**, **Voice**, and **Trump** is to the Bride.
