

MESSAGE EVANGELISM IN THE **PHILIPPINES**

ropagating the Message-of-the-Hour in the Philippines is a challenging task. It took some years to quicken the predestinated seeds of God in this country out of Nicolaitanism and out from denominationalism and into the light of the full revelation of the Word of God as brought about by the end time ministry of Malachi 4:5,6

and Revelation 10:7.

The Republic of Philippines is a sprawling archipelago set in the western Pacific Ocean. It consists of 7,107 islands that are categorized broadly under three main geographical divisions: Luzon, Visayas, and Mindanao. The capital city of the Philippines is Manila and the most populous city is Quezon City

wherein I live. There are about 186 different languages in the Philippines but the main national language is Tagalog or Filipino.

With a population of about 100 million people today, the Philippines is the seventh-most populated country in Asia and the 12th most populated country in the world. Its location on the Pacific Ring of Fire and close to the equator makes the Philippines prone to earthquakes and typhoons.

10%. Protestants are estimated to be only more than 4% of the total population. The remaining percentage is divided between a number of religious groups including Hindus, Jews, and Baha'is. The Americans retained sovereignty over the islands after the Spaniards until 1945. And

> after World War II, the Philippines was recognized as an independent nation.

> The Message of the Hour in the Philippines is gaining grounds today. When transportation and the internet were not yet in place, ministers had to walk through rugged mountains, cross rivers and raging seas, just to reach out and

do mission work over all the provinces and the different islands. There were very few tapes and Spoken Word books during such time such that only a very limited understanding of the Message was grasped by the people. But nowadays, there are almost more than 200 Endtime Message churches nationwide, both huge and small, thriving all over the country. Thanks to the hard labours and dedication of our local ministering brothers who





The Philippines was colonized by the Spaniards in 1521 and became part of the Spanish Empire for more than 300 years. It was named in honor of King Philip II of Spain which then resulted in the predominance of the Catholic religion. About 79% of the population are Roman Catholics while Islam comprises more than

tirelessly spend their time and effort looking for the lost sheep of Christ in this part of the world

Thanks also to the foreign missionaries who came and have done their part. I for one was converted by just reading the Seven Church Ages Book alone which somebody gave to me in 1987. Coming out of a Catholic background and being attracted to Pentecostalism, I finally found the truth in the Message of the Hour. I started pastoring in 1994 after sitting under a Message Church for 7 years. From then on, I was led to design various tracts on the Message and distributed them in the markets, in bus stations and in hospitals until people began to call us and were wanting to be baptized in the Name of Jesus Christ.

Our congregation started with just myself and my family and has grown now to around 170 people including women and children. Thanks also to the advancement in information technology. The Filipino Bride has access to the gained

Message through online websites, MP3's and PDF documents. Believers can now read and listen to the Message through laptop computers, and Android Smart Phones.

The first missionaries to ever bring the Message-of-the-Hour in the Philippines, as I can recall, wayback in the 70's and 80's, were Brother Searle

from Gisborne~New Zealand Brother Harold Hildebrandt from Edmonton~Alberta, Canada, Brother Larry Hart, Bro. Samuel Johnson, Bro. Madox, Brother Ted Posedly, among others. The first Voice of God Recording Library was set-up in Bacolod City through Bro Aladdin Zanoni way back in the 80's. Then it was relocated to San Pedro, Laguna in the early 90's through Bro Danny Bernardo. In 1994, it

was moved to Grace Village~Quezon City under the auspices of businessman John Silverio. Presently, it now has its own buliding at VGR, Cubao, Quezon City under the present management of Brother Jeremiah Villagracia.

One of the proven strategies that amazingly brought the huge harvest of souls in the Philippines is through our "Mystery Expo" Seminars. The Mystery Expo Seminar is a free Gospel Message colloquium with an open invitation that is sent out to all ministers and workers of the various denominations. It is a venue wherein we are able to discuss and openly share the unveiled mysteries of the Seven Seals, the Godhead, and the history of the Seven Church Ages, the Serpent Seed Mystery, unto all who are willing to

"Whosoever listen. will, let them come."

The Mystery Expo Seminar is usually conducted within a period of one day or two, held in a hotel's function room or in a decent restaurant wherein participants are

offered free meals, free handouts, free books, posters, gospel charts, and certificates of participation.

With the concerted efforts of churches and through the help of some sponsoring missionaries who fund the event, invitations are sent out by pastors and believers to their close friends, associates, classmates, and officemates with the assurance that

> they don't have to anything and that there won't be any proselyting. They are told that all they have to do is to just come and listen; or in short, just "take it or leave it" as you fit. We believe anyway that the Message is not for everybody but only for the Bride, for she is only one in a million. main goal of Mystery Expo Seminar is of course to find lost sheep, and not goats. receive this Message, for It is hid from the eyes of the wise and the prudent. "Because we WERE SEED is the reason we could be quickened. In NON-SEED there is nothing to quicken," according to Brother Branham. But of course there will be three kinds of believers in every gathering: the true believer, the make-believer and the unbeliever.

The **Mystery Expo Seminar** aims to unveil the revealed mysteries of the end time to leaders of denominations. Whether they accept it or not, as long as they are able to hear it, that is the main thing. We all knowthat Godcould not judge a person without sending mercy first. "hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches" and are able to get in contact with the truth.

The Mystery Expo Seminar was first introduced in the country in the year 2001 by Evangelist Ernie Villanueva (a half-Canadian, half Filipino evangelist from www.bibleway.org) alongside with Brother Roel Soriano, who through the auspices of the Association of Fellow Labourers in Christ (AFLC) as headed by the late chairman Ross Franco, initiated the project. I was one of the commonly invited speakers along with fellow pastors Danny del Mundo, Nestor Espanola, and Pastor Cernan Banagan.

Through the use of live preaching coupled with multimedia technology of the Messages in Powerpoint presentations, we were able to present the Message-of-the-Hour with clarity and with impact to the audience. Theologians and Doctors of Divinity are often mesmerized to realize the truths that they were hearing which they say have never been taught nor heard from the Bible schools and seminaries where they've graduated. Mysteries such as Predestination, Original Sin, the Godhead, and more others are totally new to them.

When participants would finally ask us where

we got such deep teachings of the Bible which they've only heard for the very first time in their life (such as Abraham and Sarah having a literal body-change, and that King Saul was saved in spite of persecuting David, that the white horse rider of Revelation 6 is not the Holy Spirit but is the Antichrist, and that it was not an apple that Eve ate), that's the right moment where we introduce Brother

> Branham unto the people. We have experienced that it is always effective to present the Gospel Message (mystery-truths) first before we introduce the messenger. Remember that Eliezier never pointed Rebekah to himself when he came to the damsel. He talked more about his Master's son Isaac unto Rebekah and then she finally fell in love, not with the messenger, but with Isaac. It must be so with

us, the Bride of Jesus. We should talk more about our Bridegroom Jesus now. Didn't His prophets said, "I must decrease, He must increase."

At the end of every seminar, there is always a "Question-And-Answer" Portion wherein the participants can ask any doctrinal questions that they have in mind. And during such exchange of conversation, more and more revelations are being unveiled unto the participants so that some of them end up in being rebaptized in the Name of Jesus Christ according to Acts 2:38 when the topic on Water baptism arises. Since most of these participants are pastors and ministers of their respective denominations, once they are truly quickened to the revelation of the Word, most of them decide to embrace the Message fully. They would usually desire to re-echo what they've heard from the seminar and take It with them to their congregation to teach their members with It. Regardless of whether they continue to receive their meal tickets from their mother church or not anymore, those who are truly seed become fearless to stand for their newly-found truth. That's how most of the conversions take place in the



Philippines, through our Mystery Expo Seminars, aside from the usual tracts distribution, or the manto-man and house-to-house evangelism.

Once a predestinated servant of God has been quickened by catching the revelation of the hidden Manna for today, we find them craving for more of the fresh manna of the Word. I have

always come across lots of inquiries regarding their dire need to digest the fundamental truths sorrounding the 1,200+ sermons of God's prophet, William Branham, after seminar. each These brethren would usually ask for a quick reference guide to the Message so that they could effectively study and share this truth amongst their constituents with ease and confidence.

Having felt the

burden and necessity to address such compelling need among these young ministers in the Philippines, I have painstakingly accumulated all the essential information presently available through tapes, books and CD's that might lead to the attainment of such goal and aspiration - that is, to come up with

a handbook that will present the nittygritty of the Message in nutshell. God placed on my heart the desire to "fillin the gap" between ministers and the need for teaching modules to equip the Bride ministry with as much Wordmaterial so that its ministers are able to effectively feed the flock of God under their care with the spiritual food in due season.

Finally, after some time of praying and working, the "Quick Reference Guide" to the Message of the Hour was born in the year 2008. It was a sort of a **Preacher's Handbook** that I was able to develop to help new ministers get a full overview

of the Message of the Hour in the Philippines. The book contains major doctrinal teachings of the Bible coupled with correlating quotes from the Message of the Hour. It was able to present a concise and direct outline of topical studies which are discussed during our Mystery Expo seminars. This **Quick Reference Guide Book** is now also available for anyone

worldwide. The soft-copy of the book in PDF format can now be downloaded freely from : http://endtimemessage.info/preacher_handbook.htm. An Android App Version of the same book can be downloaded freely at Google Play by just searching and typing "ronnie millevo". It was developed by an African brother whose name is Justice Kwesi Akuffo.

Aside from the Preacher's Handbook, I have been led to design some gospel charts and **Powerpoint presentations on the Message-of-the-Hour** which

contains preaching outlines related to the End Time Message. We give them out to churches who need them for a very minimal printing cost. Anyone can avail of these charts and Powerpoints as visual aids to help you in conducting your own **Mystery Expo Seminars** in your own area. The Powerpoint files can be

viewed and downloaded at our Philippine Website address at http://endtimemessage.info/charts.htm#ppt.



William Branham 29 August 1953

15 I come home; my wife said to me; she said, "Billy, I've got bad news to tell you." Said, "Your good friend William Hall (which was one of my converts in the Milltown Baptist church) is dying with cancer." I said, "Surely not Brother Hall?"

"Yes." Said, "Dr. Dillman of Cordon has told him that he can't live no longer; he's dying." Said, "He brought him up to New Albany. He's out here with some of his peoples now, dying." I went to see him that night. He'd lost some fifty pounds, real yellow all over. The cancer was in the liver, a very seriously. I had prayer for him the next day. I went back, and he was still worse. I had prayer for him again that evening. I went back and he was almost gone. I had prayer for him again.

16 Mrs. Hall, which is a good friend of mine (I've lived in their home), she said, "Brother Billy, is there anything that you can do?" I said, "Only thing I can do, Sister Hall, is ask God." She said, "Well, is there any... you know of any medical?" I said, "Well, now look, doctors are just like ministers or anything else. You have to have confidence in them." I said, "Of course, my little friend Dr. Adair here, we was school boys together. And we've always been very close friends. I think as far as medical science, he's the

tops." Said, "Wonder if he'd come down and see Mr. Hall?" I said, "I'll ask him."

17 I called up the doctor, and he said, "Well, Billy," said, "I could down there." But said, "I'll just go look at the x-rays." Said, "If they've x-rayed him, cancer is there. Told... they'd tell Dr. Adair. And a doctor called me, said, "Billy?" And I said, "Yes, doctor?" He said, "Well, the... Your friend Mr. Hall," (now here's the remark) said, "he going to jump overboard in the next four days." I said, "I hate to hear that doctor. Nothing you can do?"

18 Said, "Billy, we can't take the man's liver out and him live." Said, "Just what he's got, just- -he just live on." Said, "His time has come." And he said, "If he's a minister, he ought to be prepared to die" I said, "Oh, he's prepared to die." But I said, "He's fairly a young man yet, 'bout fifty-six, fifty-eight years old. Much work he could do for the Lord. I hate to hear that, Dr. Adair." He said, "But he's going to go." Said, "Able seen the same thing that we seen. And we give him the test and he's cancered. His liver's completely eat up with a cancer." I said, "Yes, sir." I said, "Well, thank you very much." I said, "I'll pay you."

19 Of course, he never would take pay for anything he did for a Christian, or believer.

minister. And so I said... I went down and I told Mrs. Hall, I said, "Well, Miss Hall, I'll--I'll give

you the message, you come out." And I said, "The doctor said he'd be dead in four days." And

she started screaming. I said, "Now Sister Hall, as many times as Brother Hall and I have

stood in the pulpit and preached together, and we've talked of the lovely Jesus..."Said, "Oh,

but I just don't know what I'll do without him." I said, "Well, God's perhaps calling him home, Mrs. Hall." I said, "We'll go in and pray."

20 And my secretary, and my wife, my mother-in-law, and many of us, we went in to pray. He was just almost unconscious, just yellow as he could be, and someone rubbing on his hands, and his eyes sunk way back, real yellow: liver condition, you know, the cancer. So I went home. And the next morning I was to leave to go into Toledo, Ohio, Erie, Pennsylvania, coming home for one day, having one night at the high school gym in Jeffersonville, and then was going to Africa from there. And I'll never forget it. I'm--I was borned in Kentucky. I... My conversion never kept me from liking to hunt squirrels. I--I still like to squirrel hunt. So I thought I'd get out early the next morning, if nobody was there, and the house got empty about

twelve o'clock. And I got my little twenty-two rifle and set it down in the corner, and my old--old coveralls, and was going to get ready to go hunting.

21 Three o'clock the--the alarm went off. I got up and put on my clothes, and looked out on the runway, coming in the driveway, rather, and there was no one setting out there. So I thought, "Well, I'll--be all right for me to leave now." And I wasn't so much going hunting as just to get away to rest a little bit. So I started through to the bathroom, and as I look—started into the hallway, there was a little green apple about that big, and it was real knotty, and worms all through it, looked like had eaten holes in it. It was hanging; I thought, "Well, what did my wife put that on the wall for?" Thought of... "That would be awful." And just a little old knotty, green, sour-looking apple, hanging on the wall...

22 Well, I thought, "My, I'd have put something different from that on the wall." And I was just amazed at it, 'cause the light in the hall was kinda shining in, and I was just noticing at the corner as I passed. And I happened to look, it was moving up-and-down. And it wasn't on the wall. It was hanging right out in the air. So I knew that there was something going on. I slipped over to the corner, set my rifle down, took off my big old hat. I knelt down. I said, "What would my Father have His servant know?" And I just watched. Down come another one just like it and stood by it, and another, and another, until five of them stood there. And then down came a great big apple, kind of a yellow-looking with red streaks in it. And it just made a big grab like that, and swallowed one, two, three, four, five. And then the apple went away. And just above it was that Light that you see in the--the picture that they've taken, was standing above it: Which is the Angel of the Lord, which does all these things that you see at night.

23 He was standing above there. It kind of makes, kinda goes, "Whew, whew!" milling, like that. And I said, "What would my Lord have His servant know?" He said, "Stand up." I stood up. He said, "Go tell Mr. Hall THUS SAITH THE LORD, he will not die, but live." No squirrel hunting that day. I hurried as hard as I could. Went back in the room and woke my wife up. I said, "Sweetheart?"

She said, "Are you going hunting?"

I said, "No, honey. I just met the Angel of the Lord there at the door and He told me to go tell Brother Hall that He said that he wasn't going to die." And she started weeping. And I changed clothes real quick and went down to Mr. Hall's, and I said... went in. They was just--it was just breaking day. And they just

all, just almost gone. And they had him up. He was kinda semiconscious.

24 And I run into... I said... they said, "Howdy do, Brother Branham." And I said, "Sister Hall?

All of you gather, everyone in the room. I have THUS SAITH THE LORD." Mmm. Nothing's going to stop that. No matter what it is. All the devils that Satan could send out of hell, that has nothing to do with it, not a thing. When you hear that spoke in this building here, over something, just watch what takes place. Or anybody here that's ever heard it anywhere, through the entire lifetime of His unworthy servant, if you've ever heard that come forth, watch what follows it. It's always perfect.

Architectural Plans for the Third Temple have begun

Today, on the Fast of Av, Jews throughout the world mourn the destruction of the two Holy Temples of Jerusalem and pray for the rebuilding of the Third Temple. But one organization has been doing a lot more than just praying.

The Temple Institute has released a modern three-dimensional architectural rendition of the future Third Holy Temple, utilizing the latest building material and techniques. The vivid, three-minute video walks viewers through the main sanctuary, showcasing decades of research and tens of innovative Halakhic (Jewish law) solutions to various perplexing issues that were resolved to create fully functional, ready-to-use plans.

While staying true to the Halakhic requirements and dimensions, the project also adds some clear modern twists. As the visual tour sweeps through the sanctuary, one can see the menorah, incense altar and showbread table, all of which have already been prepared by the Institute, among 70 other sacred vessels.

The presentation was specially released to coincide with the Ninth of Av, the Jewish national day of mourning which commemorates the destruction of the First and Second Temples. The video comes one year after the Temple Institute appealed to its supporters to take part in an Indiegogo crowd funding campaign that raised over \$100,000 for the architectural plans. The video was first released to supporters of a current campaign to raise the first kosher Red Heifer in Israel in over 2,000 years. Over the past five years, the organization has released its most ambitious campaigns and poignant videos to reframe the mourning period into one of active preparation for the Third Holy Temple.

Rabbi Chaim Richman, International Director of The Temple Institute noted that one of his organization's key aims is to educate Jews about the centrality of the Temple to Judaism, after nearly 2,000 years without it. "One third of all Torah commandments pertain to the building of and service in the Holy Temple," Rabbi Richman noted. "Today, we not only mourn the destruction of the two Holy Temples, but also our inability to fulfill one third of the Torah."

"Over the last three decades, the Temple Institute has done everything in our power to research and prepare for the Third Temple. As world Jewry sits on the ground mourning the first two Temples, we have taken a huge leap towards the rebuilding, by releasing a 3D architectural rendition of the Third Temple.

The Temple Institute is the center of research and preparation for the Holy Temple. In addition to educational activity focused on the centrality of the Temple Mount and Holy Temple, the Institute have also recreated over 70 sacred vessels for use in the Third Holy Temple, which can be seen at their Visitors Center in the Old City of Jerusalem.

HE THAT IS IN YOU

God's purpose and plan is to tabernacle and dwell in the flesh of His Family. Jesus Christ was the beginning of the creation of God, and the New Testament saints are the continuation of the same Creation. Through election, the great Creator is taking on form by creating Himself apart of His creation from His thoughts, to spoken word, to flesh. The consummation of this is to be fully manifested in the flesh of His end time Bride, as the wife is the glory of her husband. The Bible is the story of God unfolding or changing Himself from the eternal Spirit alone with His thoughts, to the manifestation of those eternal thoughts in the glorified flesh of His sons and daughters. His true revelation and purpose is being realised in a threefold manner.

First. He has revealed the fullness of Himself in Christ so that, secondly, He might have the preeminence in His Body of believers to live in His people, His Bride and Temple not made with hands; and thirdly, to restore the Kingdom to the perfections of Eden before the Fall. John the Baptist was the Elijah who introduced the first coming of Christ when the fullness of God came to dwell in the temple of The Lord Jesus. Brother Branham was the Elijah who foreran the second coming of Christ when Christ comes to dwell in His Bride. The second coming of The Lord, as described in 1st THESSALONIANS **4:16**, was not a corporal body of Jesus the Man coming to earth as in His first coming; it was the secret coming of Christ in Word form through the mouth of His prophet as declared in MATTHEW 24:27: For as the lightning cometh out of the east, and shineth even unto the west; so shall also the coming of the Son of man be. A universal global coming of Light shining upon and revealing The Word. The Lord Himself descended from heaven with a shout (the Message) for the purpose of uniting His bride with Him in agreement with His Word, and thus abiding in them.

This is the Bride coming of Christ; Christ on earth again in the human flesh of His Bride. It is at this second coming that He fully incarnates the temple of His many-membered Bride Body; she has always been in His thoughts from the beginning, but now through the mouth of a vindicated Prophet she is coming from spoken word to flesh. All that was in God He poured into Christ, and all that was in Christ He poured into the Church. The capstone of Christ in you. It is none other than Jesus Christ Himself incarnate in the believer; God and man in union again as it was with Adam, walking in perfect agreement and oneness.

This is what the invisible union of the Bride to Christ is all about, a physical, bodily coming of the Lord Jesus as His first coming could not have achieved this as His purpose was to be **in** us. If we are caught up into heavenly places and have met Him face to face by seeing Him revealed in His Word, then we shall soon be caught up in the air at the rapturing of the Bride when we shall see Him face to face in His physical form. He that is in you is the full Word of God revealed to your heart restoring the original faith and fulfilling Malachi 4's prophecy. Denominations cannot produce this.

Now if the same Spirit which raised Christ from the dead dwells in us, it will quicken our mortal bodies to The Word. If our bodies and spirits are NOT coming subject to The Word, then we need to look carefully at what we are feeding on. Please let me repeat this: If our bodies are NOT becoming subject to The Word, then it shows that we are not feeding on The Word but on the world, for it is what a man sows that he reaps. If you sow Christ, The Word, into your mind and heart then His Life will automatically in due season begin to live out. I have been told that up to eighty percent of learning is done through visual observation. Is it any wonder why Satan uses so much visual temptation in this last age. He is preaching and teaching his message of deception by having his sermons lived out before us by the postmodern culture displayed so eloquently by the masses, and if we're not careful and on guard we'll subconsciously buy into it and then wonder why we are backslidden and powerless to overcome, when the Bible said to flee the very appearance of evil. Yet some of us still watch TV in our homes in direct disobedience to what the Prophet said. I would like to earnestly encourage each one to desperately sow the Seed of the Word of God into your hearts as diligently as you can, and instead of watching "We Love Suzy", put on a message tape and/or read your Bible and pray. Draw nigh to Him and He will draw nigh to you. Like the little boy in the story who ate the rubber off the bicycle peddles to get the sulphur, whatever you have to do to get the vitamins of the Word into your soul, lay aside all else and do that. Rev.3:20b "if any man hear my voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with me".

Be strong and of good courage; in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him that loved us, because He that is in you is greater than he that is in the world.

Convention Fee: SAT\$40 per person per day (Three(3) Days Convention), Half Price for children under 10, Free for infants.

- Items included in the Fee: Cost of Venue for the Convention, Cost of accommodation at Lalomanu Beach Fales (beach experience), All Convention Meals; Breakfast/Lunch & Dinners, Beddings will be provided (sheet, pillows, mosquito net, mattresses. Fales are open Samoan thatched bungalows on the beach. Shared showers and bathrooms each for men and women. Name Tags and Convention materials. Lalomanu Beach will be closed to tourist during the Convention so it will be exclusive for the Convention attendance.
- Things to bring with you to Camp Site: Your BIBLE, note book, pen, island clothes, and semi formal
