Vietnam Missions





On the 23rd of September, I flew once again to Saigon and the following day we travelled by Grab-taxi into the rural areas of the south. The weather at this time of the year is very changeable and after arriving at our base in a local town, we headed to the rubber plantation group by motorbike in fine weather. To get to the church you have to go down a steep track through the rubber trees and in the middle of the plantation amongst millions of trees, a small church is located. The whole day was spent there and during the time a heavy dose of rain arrived which meant that getting out of the plantation at the end of the day was going to be a mission

God bless you brethren. As usual, I wish to keep my sponsors up to date with the missions work in Vietnam so that you can see where your sacrifices have been utilized. on it's own.

Trying to get back up the hill caused all the motorbikes to end up horizontal so we had to manoeuvre them up without riders on the seats. Then once on the level we headed back into town and continued the meetings locked away in a hotel room to avoid the authorities.

It was in this room that we went into the subject of the cloud on Sunset Mountain and the fulfilling of the "return of the high priest". To the true message believers this is the 7th Seal in its manifestation to bring the Bride into perfect faith for a body change. To say the least, many eyes were opened to scripture being fulfilled in their day.

he following day we headed back to Saigon to take a sleeper bus trip of 8 hours north to another rural town to spend some time with an independent group. These independent groups are separate from the denominations which are registered with the government. However for us they are contacts to make inroads in getting the message of the hour made known amongst



Christians that want reality. The following day we stayed at Dalak which is the home city of the ex-King of Vietnam who was deposed in 1954. Here the weather again packed in so we had a look around the city until we could catch another

sleeper bus for a 6 hour trip further north to half way up the country.

In the mountain area there are some message churches that have been around a few years that needed some furtherance added to their understanding. So again the 7th Seal was preached to them and also teaching them the right way for communion and foot washing.

The next day we headed further north again by sleeper bus into the rural areas where no for-



eigners are permitted. I will give no names for this area.

Here in this we met many independent groups and I had to conceal myself from the public with a mask and sunglasses. However the disguise wasn't good enough and somebody contacted the police and "the chase was on"!!! The part I

> really love about missionary work is the risk involved. The police do not want foreigners to go into these areas because they think that they will stir up the people against the government. But this is what makes missionary work so exciting knowing that you can get arrested if caught.

We got on our motorbikes and went from one inde-

pendent group to the next meeting the pastors and praying for their respective churches. While this was going on the police were looking in the wrong places as we didn't stay in one area any longer than 15 minutes. Understand that rural Vietnam is not like the cities that tourists go to. This is a 3rd world environment where the fields are still ploughed using water buffalo and a foreigner is rarer than an honest politician.





The next day we decided to head about 90 KMs further west by bus to avoid the hunt and went to a wonderful group of people right off the beaten track. More contacts were made and invitations received to come back and bring the message amongst the common rural people there. Understand that all Christian groups are monitored and are not allowed to associate in a united way. However I don't recognize what the authorities want if there are Saints that need to hear the word.

After a whole day in this area, the police had finally found out where I had ended up and phoned the pastor that they knew a foreigner was with him. But again it was too late. They



don't know who I am and don't know where I come from and no one is telling them!!! We got on a public bus and headed out to the nearest city to catch a sleeper bus for a 16 hour trip back to Saigon. A sleeper bus is a huge vehicle with beds and no seats. They are used for long distance travel during the night.

Back in Saigon we had some more small meetings and some straight talking about what the Lord expects from us in this late hour.

What made this visit so significant is the hunger the people have for the revealed word of



this day. Most of my ministerial contacts are educated theologians with enough degrees to



boil water. But when they hear the word they realize they only have an intellectual experience that will do them no good.

My intention is to head back in January and keep the ball rolling and move further north using these new contacts to set up meetings in one location at a time. I will have to change my tactics slightly by travelling at night and staying out of the public eye during the day. We had one baptism in Saigon of a woman that was ignited by the things she heard. May the Lord bless her. The printing of books is advancing and the copying of SD cards with the message and bible on. Please keep praying for this work as there is much more to be done. Shalom.

The 2017 Totovel Believer's Convention

For the last three months, you all have seen our notice of the Convention which was held here at Totovel, in the Livuan/Reimber LLG, of the Gazelle District of the East New Britain Province in Papua New Guinea. The convention started on the 24th of September to the 1st of October 2017.

The theme: "And at midnight there was a cry made, Behold, the bridegroom cometh; go ye out to meet him." Matthew 25:6

On the morning of the 24th September, brothers Nicholas Angai, Anton Yawai and John Yembe arrived on-board MV Chebu, a Ferry that services the New Guinea Islands and the mainland. In the evening we had an Introductory Fellowship. That evening we also opened a house build by Brother Marum Pennias and Sister Serah, purposely for ministers to reside in when ministering at Totovel Believer's Christian Fellowship.



On Monday the 25th, we had services in the morning. Brother Ben Gloyne arrived in the afternoon and preached in the evening, especially letting the people know what hour we are living in.

From Tuesday to Friday, we experience and saw what the Lord did in each of the meetings, we the local ministers and our Brother Ben preached the Word in the morning and evening sessions. 
I would like to thank the Lord Jesus Christ for those who have supported in prayer, monies and kind for we must know that
