

We have just arrived back to New Zealand from a three week trip through Vietnam. This trip took us from the bottom to the top of the nation, sounding the Trumpet, and giving out handfuls of SD cards full of the Message of the hour in Vietnamese. We discovered several new groups, and saw the power of God come on the scene and open up the Word to people who have lived under denominational and idolatrous veils all their lives. Freedom is real!

The climate in Vietnam ranges from around 12°C all the way up to 45°C with most places averaging 37°C with 100% humidity being common. We all know that the natural types the spiritual so with this natural weather pattern we find a very similar spiritual and cultural climate, which we faced head on in both the ministry, and in dealing with the locals from all walks of life. The climate for mission work in Vietnam has been this way for many years.






The

Word has gone forth in Vietnam for about 20 years with some long intervals between efforts. Through this time there have been many challenging obstacles to overcome, and by the Lords grace the Bride has started to emerge through the murky waters of the muddy ponds of Vietnamese culture.

People with impure motives who raised up in various regions are starting to filter out and make way for those true humble believers who sincerely deisre to walk in the fullness of the Word and give everything they have, from their hearts, to the work of the Lord.

This may sound very normal to many who read this but when working in Vietnam, one will realize this is a major breakthrough. Now a five-fold ministry can flourish and real faith can manifest in the people whose eye and motives are single unto the Lord.







Our next meetings were held in Sis Phuong's apartment. Sister Phong has been a believer for a number of years and has been instrumental in the organisation and administration of the work in Vietnam. She invited a group of ministers who she met when some trouble arose in the previous months. A certain man was attempting to take control over the group and bring the entire Work under his jurisdiction.

After his motive was exposed he started showing some serious aggression toward her publicly, a man that witnessed this, made

contact with Sis Phuong and wanted to know more about the Message. So she invited a whole group of them to hear the Message.

Being that there was a woman preacher in the group, who was actively pushing for female preachers, there were certain things spoken under inspiration that caused serious friction. However, the Lord once again powerfully came on the scene to prove His Word. We have been invited out to an island with the man in the red shirt in the picture. He is a pastor of a good sized church there.

After the meetings we had a good talk with Bro Phuoc who shared recent testimony of how God had dealt heavily in his life since Bro Adrian's last visit. He has since given more of himself to the Message. This is a huge positive for the Work in Vietnam. Bro Phuoc is a seriously gifted translator with fresh understanding of our Godly culture. To our joy, God is really moving with Bro Phuoc.

Travel to Sapa

Our next move took us from Saigon all the way up to Hanoi where we spent the night. We then bussed 6 hours up to the northern border town of Sapa. Here the real mission work con-

ditions started to emerge.

We were picked up by ministers of the National Church of Vietnam on their motorbikes. Accompanying them

was Brother Khoa and his wife. We jumped on the back of their scooters and zipped off through the jostling pot-holed streets of Sapa into the countryside screaming down winding hilled roads. Honestly, my thoughts were half praying for my life and half hoping that this man knew how to ride this

thing! After about 30

minutes of riding, the brother turned onto a small steep goat track. Just when I thought things were starting to lighten, my expectation was epically superseded...







We bumped and jumped up the track with cliff on one side and sewer streams running along the other. Thankfully I had angelic protection! You really need it in these places.

Near the top of this everlasting track, I was asked

to get off the bike as it became too steep. I was so happy to walk, in fact I would have happily run up this track with a 40kg pack, than scooter! I took some footage of the track to show the brethren back home. I spoke to Sister Phuong about the ordeal and she was worse off than me. She jokingly said she thought that she was "already dead and gone to heaven." I thought that was quite funny.

As we started the meetings, God really moved. It was like stepping into the pages of the Bible and standing as Paul stood challenging the ministries of a past age. The Lord took full possession of both of us as we preached to these people. They were not pulling on the gift, God was pushing from within. I could have sat down and watched myself speak it was so powerful. Glorious!

For two days we preached from 8am till 6pm, with breaks in between sermons. We believe great things took place in Sapa. We went right through the history of the church and journeyed from Eden to Eden. We also went through adoption and true baptism.

There was a real desire in the mens hearts to be bap-

tized correctly and some even put their hands up to take true baptism. Throughout the meetings, we watched the reactions of the men and out of 40 ministers

we could spot two really genuinely interested men who we got their numbers and one even invited us back to his church of 200 when we return to Sapa next time. We tested this man and offered him money to see his reaction. He

refused it profusely. This is a great sign.

there again and they were all given SD cards with 600 Messages in Vietnamese to listen to. God is calling His bride in Sapa and your prayers for this work are really coveted and appreciated.

Our hearts deisre and prayer is that God raise up humble and gifted men called to minister to take this Message to their own people.

After such a success (not without its challenges) in Sapa, we journeyed by bus two days south-east to Quang Ngai in central Vietnam.

The bus trip was the worse experience I have ever had traveling. It was so bad, that all we could do was laugh about it. If you see the photos below, we were placed at the very back in a cave of a place just above the

engine. In brother Adrians words 'It was only 3 degrees cooler than hell'. Generally when you get into a bus, you start to cool off from 45°C 100% humidity but on this bus, packed in like sardines, you get hotter and be-

come more sticky than children's hands who have eaten candy-floss for three days. Then just to help cement that sticky coating, the bus driver decided he wanted add cigarette smoke to our growing skin batter. After 18 hours, I was ready for the fry pan, and what better fry pan than right above the bus engine! Ok perhaps it wasn't that bad, I'm just having a little fun.

Like I said, all we could do was have a good laugh and thank the Lord for allowing us to suffer for His name. I asked Sister Phuong to take some pho-

tos of the sunset in the background. When she took the photo, the Lord supernaturally placed a cross in the image as an encouragement for us. Not that we have really even come close to what He went through, al-

though it was a nice blessing from the Lord.

In Quang Ngai they have rarely seen white people so we became their gazing stock as we sat down for coffee at the bus stop after we disembarked

the bus from hell. It was so good to be out of 'jail' and into 45°C 100% humidity again. The desire to shower was strong, but we were destined for some meetings first so off we went to Brother David Lip's place. Brother David is a Message believer, he was born blind. He leads a small group in the remote farms of Quang Ngai near a region called Lac Ha. He also helps us to translate on the Skype meetings especially into the local dialect in this region. We jumped on bikes and headed to his village for some food and some spiritual fellowship. See photos. We had great fellowship here. I was also able to help setup Bro Davids laptop so he is able to work on it with no sight

he next group in Quang Ngai was about 50 people with four very zealous and sincere young ministers, who we got on with like a house on fire. We had some really great times of fellowship here with these brethren. They picked us from our hotel and masked us completely over, to avoid unwanted police attention on their moterbikes way

We entered their church building which was completely open in the front, so passers by could see right in. Because of this exposure we decided to


have meetings sitting around the table to avoid any issues if police did decide to investigate, they could come and join the meeting. The first meeting went really well and after about an hour of teaching from the Open Book, 'Lo and behold' a team of police officers turned up and

stood outside watching and taking notes.

I decided it was time to smile, wind down the message, and hand the service over casually to another minister to carry on in their language so as not to arise any

suspision from our guests. After about an hour of photos, silent prayer, and intense interrogation; the Lord gave us favor, and the police left.

Before they left, we gave them an SD card with the Message on it. They were hap-





After a few sessions preaching and teaching the brethren in Lac Ha, we found out they were very interested in joining us online with meetings on Zoom, a video conference platform we use. In the picture below you can see Bro Adrian working with the brothers to sort out their system and set up the Zoom meetings. We discovered they

needed a laptop to make it work as their phones were not working through the monitors.

So the next day we met the brothers and went to the local computer store and bought a mid-range laptop for them and then spent the day in our hotel (see below photo) teaching and fellowshipping around the Word whilst I loaded their computer with the relevant software and settings. God really ministered to the brothers, we had a great time of fellowshipp with them. They are very sincere and open to hear the Word of God in fulness without

Next region, Nga Trang, is a popular tourist city along the mid-eastern coast about 8 hours south of Quang Ngai. We arrived in Nga Trang and found a good cheap hotel to stay in. This place was in stark contrast to what we had come from. After a nights rest we hired motorbikes and headed for the mountains where Brother Bobo and his church live which

was about 60km away.

In most countries, doing this would be considered a standard venture. However, in Vietnam this is very far from normal practise for

foreigners. Our trip consisted of three hours of weaving through countless motorbikes, pot holes, and navigating with Google 'mouth' through the maze of Vietnam's wonderful lack of street signs. After nearly being impailed, skidding over onto the sidewalks, getting mowed down by trucks, and nearly jumping out of my skin when the busses blast their freight ship horns at you, we made

it by the Lords grace.

When we arrived at the church, we had a good fellowship around the lunch table and

were treated like kings from the Brethren here. It was a very welcome, pleasant surprise.

Brother Adrian and Sis Phuong both remarked that something big has changed with this group. They are developing into a Godly church. After dicussion with brother Bobo, we found out why there had been such a change over the past 6 months. God had allowed the brethren to go through some heavy trials, and by God's grace they are coming through

refined as gold.

Due to the fruit of the Spirit in this group, there was such a liberty with these bretheren, and God visited the service in a powerful way. We ministered on a heavenly economy and a faith civilization and this was well received. Something wonderful is taking place with the brethren in Nga Trang.

There was a certain quality of divine charater we all noticed in these people, which I had not seen such in Vietnam up until this point. It was greatly refreshing to witness this in such a volatile mission field.

The fruit is on the vine and with the ABC's coming into place with the brethren now,

the Lord can really bring them into greater things and bring

them into the "Algebra." Considering we only took one meeting in this area, it was very satisfying to see how God moved and we look forward to returning to see the fruit as it matures on the Vine.






Finding The Vietnam Bride

The next day, we travelled by bus another 5 hours over the moutains to another remote moutainous town called Dalat. We then travelled from Dalat over to a small farming village called Lam Dong, here we were treated very well by Bro Thanh and Sister My who are very sincere believers and are very hungry for the truth we have. These people are gold and really have something real. They would have us pay for nothing our entire stay and make sure we were well fed, even if it was animals that we dont usually eat.



One lady from the village had a dream that two foreigners will come to minister at Thanh My's house. In her dream sister My phoned her and invited to the meetings. When she awoke from sleep, she received the call from sister My that she had dreamed about, and immediately accepted the invitation. Three days later

she had an amazing time hearing the fullness of the Word for the first time. Even more amazing for her as it was being preached by the very foreigners who she had seen in her dream.



We had amazing meetings with these believers, and I am very thankful for your prayers. God is moving in this region and calling His bride. Things may be small, but the quality is really high. Please pray for the brethren here in Lam Dong, Dalat. They are really catching the Word and walking in the light as It unfolds. There are others to come in here, and they need to see laborers in the vinyard taking this Message throughout the land by the local ministry. May God establish them in present truth.









Next we headed south another 8 hours by bus to have a final meeting with Bro David Phouc and his church full of zealous faithful young people. He is the pastor here in this region three hours north of Saigon.

Great news for the Work, Bro Phuoc accepted to become our travelling translator for future trips which

is awesome. I believe this is a miracle from God. Bro Phuoc has been through some massive trials since Bro Adrian's last trip. He had some major turning points to work through with the Lord in regards to this Message and also his own business etc.

A positive change has taken place. Let's pray that these brethren will come fully into the Message and be established in present Truth. They all react to and love the Word we preach but there needs to be a new birth for these people. Pray that they will fully surrender everything to the Work of God for this day.

The final meeting at Brother Phuoc's church was an awesome time in the Lord and there was a tremendous time in His presence. It was about 45°C

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Israel: The Deepest Mystery of Torah



Shalom and greetings once again in Jesus name.

Jews around the world follow a weekly scripture reading. This past month they were once again faced with what they consider as the most profound and deepest mystery in *Torah* – the sacrifice and cleansing by the ashes of the Red Heifer.



They have pondered for millenniums this ordinance that combines two entirely opposite elements. A command given to *purify* the unclean – incredibly, renders the pure *impure*. What is it about this divine ordinance that the "pure" Priest who performs this special service, becomes *defiled*? Why would God give a command, and refuse to make known? Would understanding somehow spoil some vast eternal plan? And to cap it off, the wording in the original Hebrew includes an emphasis that this was a "*chalut*" command, in other words, beyond questioning and beyond man's understanding!

And so Jews continue to pray and wait for the revelation to this day. Many believe this will come by Moses, who they unequivocally believe was given the understanding. Accordingly, this commandment is more related and connected to Moses than to any other figure. As such, the red heifer is even referred to as the *cow of Moses*. How fitting it is then that Moses *must* - and will *return* - to expound not only this truth, but the truth of many other scriptures in order to prepare the elect out of the Nation of Israel for redemption at Messiah's appearing!

But God is moving by His Spirit! Many Jews recognize that they are unquestionably in the season of their redemption. Redemption however, is predicated by cleansing. When the 2nd Temple was destroyed 2,000 years ago and the land subsequently occupied by foreign powers, it was defiled and became "unclean". Likewise, Jews scattered throughout the world became "defiled". Even though they have returned to Israel, they reside in an unclean state of "*Tumat Met*".

The <u>only</u> scripturally prescribed means whereby the land and the people can be cleansed and readied for the coming of Messiah, is by the cleansing of a Red Heifer. For this reason it is inseparably linked and regarded as the essential component for redemption. Thus, finding and preparing the sacrifice of the red heifer is <u>the</u> premier event or "first step" that initiates and sets in motion all other preparations made for Israel's redemption. Not only is Israel's restoration and redemption regarded as *impossible* without this cleansing, many Jews also regard the fact that their being "*impure*" hinders and prevents them from receiving further spiritual light and understanding from scriptures.



Rabbi Richman of the Temple Institute summarizes the great imperative of finding a red heifer and of being able to prepare the essential ashes from its sacrifice:

"The Divine ordinance of the red heifer, beyond the grasp of man's frail intellect, with all the details of its preparation and ceremony, calls out to Israel and to all who seek to cling to the living word of the

God of Israel: 'Purify yourselves! Shake off your despair! Death is an illusion!' Thus it is written, '... but all of you who cling to the Lord your God are all alive today.'" (Deuteronomy 4:4)

How significant and important it is then, that less than three years ago, the Temple Institute undertook a special project to begin breeding pure red cows. Rabbi Richman has recently stated that a red heifer is now <u>ready!</u> Watch Rabbi Chaim Richman in this short, 2 minute video expound on this incredibly important project.

"...Make no mistake, this project is nothing less than the 1st stage of the reintroduction of biblical purity into the world, a prerequisite for the rebuilding of the Holy Temple." Rabbi Chaim Richman [https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=nHnjOiagh-g]

This ordinance of the red heifer reverberates with the testimony of the greatest of miracles - the ability to purify the impure. It is the tangible demonstration of the glorious truth and power that both rectifies death and transforms one into the purity of eternal life. Brother Branham too referred to how the "…red heifer was a type of Christ…"

As the time of Messiah and Israel's redemption draws closer, Jews are awakening to the deeper mystery hidden within; That a *pure* servant, will Himself become *impure* – for the cleansing and redemption of the Nation.

"If my friend falls into a mud-pile, will I not naturally become sullied and muddied myself in the process of lifting him out? Built into the very enterprise of purifying the defiled is the fact that the purifier himself must be touched by some of the impurity! One of the signs of the imminent arrival of the Moshiach - is the birth of a red heifer. Its ashes will prepare us for true eternal life and the resurrection of the dead." Rabbi G.

But what about this sacrifice – is it to be fulfilled today? In Matt 5:17-18 we read the following words of Jesus;

Think not that I am come to destroy the law, or the prophets: I am not come to destroy, but to fulfil. ^[18] For verily I say unto you, Till heaven and earth pass, one jot or one tittle shall in no wise pass from the law, till all be fulfilled.

Was Jesus alluding to an actual, literal future fulfillment of this very ordinance? That after 2,000 years revelation will come to the Nation of Israel - when they see the truth unfold in the literal fulfillment of God's ordinances to them? That's exactly what Brother Branham said would happen; "...Revelations 11...the ministry of Moses and Elias calling to Israel...to call Israel out of the old atonement of the lamb, and sheep, and blood, and goats, and sacrifice, to the real living Sacrifice, to the Word." "



How amazing it is for us to be living in the times of the very ushering in of God's redemption for Israel – which includes our redemption! May the wonderful revelation of God's provision for cleansing the individual stained and defiled by death, be fulfilled and enacted soon! Let us pray and also do what we can to realize the fulfillment of the Word of God.
