It is my joy to write this brief report of our Mission Activities from July to October 2020.

OIndia reopening amid a spike in cases O

India's government announced plans to end a national lockdown that began on 25 March. This was expected - the roads, and even the skies, have been busy for the last one month since restrictions started to ease for the first time in six months. Many businesses and workplaces are already open, construction has re-started, markets are crowded and parks are filling up. Hotels, restaurants, malls, places of worship are opened with some restriction and schools and colleges will also reopen, soon.

Preaching in Lockdown

The world is under lockdown but the Gospel is not. The gospel does not have any restrictions and its movements are not limited. The



gospel refuses to be masked, and it knows no social distancing. It remains the power of God unto salvation to everyone who believes (Rom 1:16).

I deeply miss the usual context for fellowship and it can be disheartening and disorientating that we cannot meet

in person to sing, pray, talk, listen, bless, and encourage one another. But I have come to the conclusion that not a lot has changed for preaching

For decades we have seen God using media in the lives of many people through tapes, CDs, and digital audio ministries. We must adapt to the new

situation. We have the technology to do so. That's what we doing and we think it is right to put things online for our people



to encourage and keep them warm. This went out great blessings to our local people and others joining with us. We are having our continued online services on the Skype, Zoom and Facebook every day.



Keep Preaching


Lord inspires me to make a What's App group to share the

Sharing Jesus Door to Door

While there are many ways of reaching people these days, especially with social media, it



appears God continues reaching people through door to door evangelism.

Bro. William Stephen and <u>Mandip Singh who came from a non</u> <u>Christian background</u> started to spread the Gospel in their district.

Because of their hard work and with the Lord's help, they have reached around 200

families and distributed some 2000 Message books, New Testament and other literatures and tracts. They are not evangelists, brother William is a student while brother Mandip works as a Color Paint job. But their passion for the Lord is





immense. While testifying about the work they told me following things:

"Every week we go for outreach as a team with gospel literature to different areas. We primarily work as a team on foot, doing door to door evangelism, sometimes with a bike or sometimes with a vehicle

according to the need and resources." When we go door to door, we always remember to be polite even when the people we visit are

not. A Christ-like life will win people, while winning an argument will not. Also be encouraged that if they are not interested, that you are only one of many opportunities God will send their way. The most areas we went were Hindus; by nature most of the Hindu is very



negative about Gospel and Christian literature as you know our Hindu Government falsely abusing the Christians that they convert people by giving them money. The persecution of Christians in India increased sharply since present govt has started ruling. Solicit your prayers for these brothers as they are committed to distribute the Christians literatures everywhere they can reach.

Construction of Church Buildings



Construction of assembly remains a large need throughout India as new

assemblies are planted and existing assemblies grow. In many parts of India it is difficult to rent facilities for the purpose of holding church meetings. The pictures both side shows the construction of a new church building in Ludhiana a biggest city in the Punjab. This Church has one of the oldest congregations in India but they were without the building but now the Lord provided and they





are able to construct this building to accommodate some 250 people.

The second church is under way in Gurdas pur area where Brother Amanat Gill ministering and the congregation is increasing very fast. Over the past few years, the church was in a little reed hut and unsafe to use in the time of rain and winds. Lord providing and we have

UGANDA AWAKENING WHEN A REVIVAL AND A

PANDEMIC COLLIDE

hen lockdowns to combat Covid-19 struck the world in mid-March 2020, Uganda boasted one of the earliest and most vigorous efforts, taking a strong "prevention" approach, though not a single case was found in its borders at that time. After a one-month review, Ugandan President Musevini renewed and increased the restrictions, to the point of decreeing a curfew from 9:00 PM to 6:00 AM, and shutting down all forms of public transportation. In his March 25th speech, the president quoted the Bible, "Finally, I want to draw your attention to a Biblical verse. In Isaiah 26:20, it says, 'Go home, my people, and lock your doors! Hide yourselves for a little while until the LORD's anger has passed."

Debates about the effectiveness of the lockdown measures may continue for a long time, but among Believers, there is little debate that this precious verse pertains to the Bride's absence during the great tribulation, not an endorsement of staying home during a pandemic. The world is not yet in the great tribulation, the rapture has not yet happened, and therefore the Bride is still being called.

Before the Covid-19 surprise hit the world, we were observing great numbers in Uganda being called to the Wedding Feast. But what happens when a pandemic and a revival collide? Surely this is a most unusual turn of events. Does the revival go on, even though the End-Time evangelists cannot travel and preach? Does the momentum die as Believers—and potential Believers—are cloistered in their homes for six months? The lowering of the Covid-19 curtain put many things into darkness, but now that restrictions are lifting, we are starting to see the answer.

Many of the newly called—called right in the middle of this dark time—are coming forward to enjoy their long-awaited baptism in the Name of the Lord Jesus Christ! Nothing can kill a true move of God. While many churches have observed a cooling off of their congregants without the weekly propping up of church meetings, the End-Time revival has continued. Quite evidently, this Word carries special power. It can restore and rejuvenate in a dark cave, or even a prison cell, just as well as in a power-packed meeting. The unique situation in Uganda underscores the fact that the power is in the Word itself, not the environment which surrounds It.

At this time, churches in Uganda have re-opened, but are limited to 70 persons in attendance to allow for social distancing. In these meetings, baptismal services are taking place, as those touched by the Word during the lockdown are coming forward. In just

one church, 32 baptisms have taken place in the past two weeks. Brand new groups are now embracing the Message, as we learned a few weeks ago when a group of Methodist minsters gathered in a remote place to hear the End-Time Word articulated by Pastor Stephen Ibale.

Needs still abound in Uganda, for Bibles, Church Age Books, and meeting places. As the curtain continues to lift, we must be prepared to support the flood of new Believers with the resources they need. Natural hunger is not an uncommon reality in poor countries such as Uganda, and as Jesus Christ said, the poor we will always have with us, and the lockdown has not helped. We do not disregard their natural needs, but our main mission is to equip Believers with the more important spiritual food, that will bring them spiritual health.

Bible Believers solicits your continued prayers as we continue to watch this unique situation unfold, staying ready to step in and help however we can. Every prayer and every financial contribution is very much needed, and much appreciated.

The following are just some of the events that unfolded during the lockdown of the last few months.

Spiritual Food Arrives in Uganda

While natural food may have been in short supply due to the aggressive lockdown that Uganda endured, spiritual food continued to be available, thanks to your ongoing support. On December 18, 2019, a team of five translators and proofreaders was added to the existing effort of Brother Fred Kiyingi to translate the sermons of Brother Branham into Luganda. This enhances the availability of these words of life for tens of thousands of new Believers, as well as the many Believers in existing Message churches. Brother Talemwa Busobozi, who helped set up the team says this:

"We currently have a team of five translators /proofreaders. Our team, I can say, consists of



some of the best that our country has to offer. We bought and furnished them with a laptop and other working materials each..."

The sermons that are published to the Message Hub are immediately available on the internet, and many Believers who are stuck in lock-down still have an internet connection and can access them. These resources are also extremely valuable to the newly baptized Pastors, who must now lead their flocks in fresh pastures.

Approximately 8 Million of the 43 Million people living in Uganda speak or understand Luganda, and many people who speak one of the smaller tribal languages can also understand Luganda. 170 Messages are now available on the Message Hub in Luganda, and this number grows by up to 10 new translations every month!

The Radio Broadcast Continues

The radio program that sparked the current revival continues to broadcast the Message out in the native language of Luganda. As millions of people were isolated in their homes, we could only wonder how many of them tuned in to the broadcast for the first time. As we were soon to discover, many were listening including ministers of various denominations.

Methodist and Pentecostal Ministers Receive the Message of the Hour

From a simple decision to broadcast the voice of William Branham on radio, translated in the Luganda language, an extraordinary move of God sprang forth in Uganda. No one



involved in that original decision could foresee how God would use the weekly broadcast. However, as we watch events unfold, we continue to be amazed as we observe the sovereignty of God in action.

"Sovereign grace is from a sovereign One. Sovereign grace from a sovereign One. Sovereign, what can it do? Sovereign can do whatever it wants to. Listen to this now. Sovereign grace can only be given by One that's Sovereign. And God is Sovereign, so He can give sovereign grace. Therefore, being sovereign, grace don't have to ask anybody; it don't has to... It does what it wants to. Isn't that wonderful? It don't has to ask, "Can I do this? Or, shall I do this? Can I? Must I? Will I?" Doesn't do it. It does it itself. Grace is sovereign; therefore, He can save the vilest. He can save the worst. He can save the impurest. He can save the immoralest. He can heal the sickest."

During the Covid shutdown, Brother Ibale received a request from a Methodist pastor to have a personal meeting with a few Methodist ministers. They had been listening to the radio broadcast and were very interested to hear more. Twenty-five Methodist pastors gathered 45km East of Iganga where Brother Ibale lives, in a town called Bubalya. The Word of God that was ministered in that meeting impacted the Methodists so mightily that they confessed they were convinced of their need for baptism in the Name of the Lord Jesus. The Lord had broken through the denominational veil of tradition to minister to and touch their hearts.

Just a few days after that meeting, Brother Fred Kiyingi met with 90 Pentecostal ministers who all rejoiced to hear the Word of God. The truth of the Godhead was revealed to them and they desired baptism; however, immersion in water had to wait, and is now taking place.

Church Ages Book Distribution

As the Message continues to broadcast out over the airwaves, and new translations are added to the Message Hub, 10,000 copies of the Church Ages Book arrived. Our first shipment



of 5000 in 2019 was used up quickly. As soon as the lock-down lifted, these books were released to the new Believers, flooding the field with the important stabilizing teaching that only the Message can bring. Getting the printed books into the country is an obstacle course of logistics and regulations, yet as we write, the majority of these books have been distributed.



Bibles Delivered in Uganda

It is amazing but true, that after centuries of missionary efforts by various groups to African nations, still large percentages of church goers own no Bible of their own. This reality is so common it has become accepted. After all, if most everyone else in your church does not own a Bible, it seems normal. It becomes accepted that Bibles are for the Missionaries, the Preachers, the wealthy, or the lucky. That is how it has always been.



It is hard for us as Believers of this End-Time Message to imagine life without a Bible. The Scriptures, with all their life-changing truth, would be something you only hear second hand, quoted by others. Many in Africa have lived their whole lives this way, including many in Uganda. Bibles have been in short supply for generations, and those Bibles that do exist are often poorly made and fall apart after a short time.

Just recently, the fruit of much giving and labour has come to maturity as 10,000 quality Luganda Bibles, along with 10,000 durable Luganda Church Age Books have landed in Uganda! Can you imagine what it would be like to receive your very own Bible for the first time in your life? Many have been Christians for years, sincere, but ill-informed about the most important thing in their life. But now, thanks to the generosity of many, they have received both of these treasures, the Bible and the Church Age Book, at the same time! A whole new world has opened up, enabling them to grow spiritually as never before. Thousands are thankful for this newfound spiritual wealth.

Utilizing our connections with commercial printers in China, we are able to print and deliver Church Age Books to Uganda for as low as \$2 each and Bibles as low as \$4 each. That means almost anyone can put a Bible in the hands of a Believer, with just a small contribution. And the person in Uganda who receives it will be changed forever.



In June, the Bibles arrived at the Bible Believers office, in the midst of the Covid shutdown. Brother Busobozi immediately delivered 2500 each to Brothers Stephen Ibale and Fred Kiyingi. They, in turn, delivered some to established pastors in regional areas. Brothers such as Brother Don Julius, and Brother Hannington Balita helped in the distribution of these great spiritual resources to local pastors. While travel was not permitted after the 7:00 PM national curfew, thousands of Bibles were distributed.

As the current revival continues to sweep Uganda, new Believers and whole churches are arriving at the End-Time banqueting table, hungry to receive God's Word. This has created an immense need for Bibles, Church Age Books, and translations. Thanks to the concern and support of many, thousands of precious Believers are now feasting as never before. Only eternity will reveal the fruits of this unique season.

CHINA "BUT THE WORD OF GOD IS NOT BOUND"

greet you in the Name of our beloved Lord Jesus Christ, who created heaven and earth and His mercy endures forever.

As the religious situation for the Believers in China grows tighter because of the complicated political circumstances around the world, the Believers there are facing more challenges than ever. Yet, like a lily in the mud they continue to grow spiritually and in number, in spite of the difficulties. God has been gracious to them.

One of the Brothers recently put in jail because of this Gospel said, "Brothers, nothing has changed. Only my place of living has changed. I still do what I always do, preach the Gospel no matter where I am."

He didn't just say it, he did exactly that. God used our Brother to lead a Muslim prisoner to the Lord. As he preached to this Muslim man, the tears ran down the man's face as he said, *"I want to know this true God that is real."* Our Brother preached to three other young prisoners that have Christian mothers, but they were not serving God. He led them back to the Lord. This shows the quality of a Believer, which only the Message can produce.

It thrills my heart to think of how many people in China and around the world have been encouraged and blessed by such testimonies from these Brothers, even as they face their darkest hour while incarcerated.

And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death. (Rev12:11)

Their stand for the Gospel has also inspired the Chinese speaking Believers in our local congregation here at Cloverdale Bibleway, and they have taken over the translation work. By God's grace, they have translated 71 messages in the past few months. The work averages out to almost 15 messages each month, which is three times more than what we did in the past! The work of the Lord has not stopped but has only multiplied in this time of gross darkness.

The Believers in China, especially the ministers, are devoted with a greater passion and fearlessness to preach the Gospel in the face of increasing pressures. They have gone out to preach, travel far and wide, baptize, hold meetings privately and online, even print the Message in their home. As one of the imprisoned Brothers preached before his arrest, using a scripture which Brother Byskal emphasized recently:

Wherein I suffer trouble, as an evil doer, even unto bonds; but the word of God is not bound. (2 Timothy 2:9)

We are truly witnessing that the Word of God is not bound and cannot be bound.

We shall continue to press toward the mark for the prize of the high calling of God in Christ Jesus with even more dedication and determination to spread the Word of this hour, for which many people have sacrificed, some even hazarding their personal safety and risking imprisonment. This one thing we do, forgetting those things which are behind, and reaching forth unto those things which are before.

May the Lord bless you as you pray for our Brothers in China as they have been and will continue to be a testimony wherever God puts them.
