From the 6th unto the 17th of March, Bro' Adrian Gray from Stratford, Bro' Ben Gloyne from Christchurch and Bro' Jerry Sellers from Phoenix, Arizona continued on with further missionary work in Vanuatu. These last five years have been increasingly fruitful and as each year passes by it has been heartening to see maturity entering into the lives of the Saints in these islands.

It has been a desire of mine to keep human ambition, ego and politics right away from these islands so that they see only one thing — Christ in His Word. 



The following is a report of The Youth Camp held in Rotorua 2010



from Thursday, 25th to 28th February 2010.

This is the sixth Camp run by Brothers: Tony Murray, Gary Walker and Paul Moffitt,

There were three camp meetings each day, on Friday, Saturday and Sunday.

Bro. Tony ministered:- "A Message for You" (in a two part series) with a powerpoint presentation:

"Navigation" (where are you at right now?) and (where is the track you are on,

Bro. Paul preached:- "What do you have to lose" - "The New Birth" - "The Record of Life:" (The Book of

Many young people came forward for prayer and rededicated their lives to the Lord and there were two baptisms.

The overall attitude at the beginning of the camp was pretty worldly which is a trend that has worsened over the years and is no doubt a reflection of their home situations (where they live, at home, at school, at church, at work etc.) – but Lord willing, many of them will be able to make a new strong stand – despite the opposition – and live victorious lives in the Lord.

By the end of camp there was a profound softening in attitude to The Word which was very encouraging to see.

As can be seen by the photo collage there were plenty of activities for the young people to test their skills and lots of laughs and fun times for all. The activities included: —
giant volley ball, balloon stomp, chinese whispers relays, pass the squeeze (boys competing opposite the girls), cardboard boat building (then a race on the pond to collect a treasure chest), spaghetti & marshmallow tower building, African chair game, rocket building and launching (coke bottles / compressed air & water — max distance 70 metres! mine field, water balloon volleyball, bonfire (burning of the boats) A guided tour through the geothermal reserve appropriately named "Hell's Gate", awards presentation ceremony, paper plane throwing contest, air rifle & archery target shooting, plus a few before-dinner tricks — which were fun in the context — "but don't try it at home"!

We were also blessed to have a lovely group of young people with us again from Brisbane, Australia this year.

Also special acknowledgment goes to the adult helpers who assisted this year. Sis Vicky Murray, Sis Deb Walker, Sis Fleur Nahi, Bro Clayton Mckenzie, Bro Matiu & Sis Naomi Noakes, Bro Tony Green, Sis Suzan Kaka, Sis Tui Smith, and two brothers from Australia, Bro Grant Bull and Bro Paul White.

In previous years we have enjoyed considerable financial support from various fellowships for these camps. We are very thankful for this support as it has made it possible for us to underwrite a significant portion of the camp fees. Earthquakes have special significance in the Bible. Jesus spoke of them and experienced them. In Brother Branham's ministry they also feature with significance. Earthquakes impacted on Laodicea – the church in Asia Minor used in Revelation to symbolise the last church age. The city was named by a Seleucid king, Antiochus II, Theos, after Laodice his wife. Overthrown often by earthquakes, it was rebuilt by its wealthy citizens, without state help, when destroyed in A.D. 62 (Tacitus, Annals 14:27).

The crunching numbers in the table below speak for themselves.

Magnitude measures the size of an earthquake by the energy released. Most seismologists now use "moment magnitude" for medium to large quakes. The scale is calculated differently from the older Richter scale, but the values produced are broadly comparable. The scale is logarithmic. Each whole number step in the magnitude scale corresponds to the release of about 31 times more energy than the amount associated with the preceding whole number value. So a magnitude 7.0 quake releases about 900 times more energy than a magnitude 5.0 tremor.

The table shows earthquakes magnitude 7 or larger as this avoids the recent data being higher just because of better reporting. The fourth column isolates those 8 or over to show that the magnitude of the birth pains is increasing, as well as their frequency.

*Website comment on the numbers: Apart from the "long-term" trends shown above, which show an ongoing persistent increase, it is perhaps more stark to record that earthquakes across the planet show a marked increase in activity since 1997. There are more major earthquakes occurring now, and this on an ever more frequent basis.

The trends in nature here, particularly from 1997 support the wider realization of prophesy about the "End Times", namely that an increase in earthquake activity is a pre-requisite for the "second coming of Jesus Christ" foretold in the Bible. It does not indicate how close we are to this event, but suggests it is not too far away. Past performance cannot necessarily be taken as a clear indication of future trends. However, it is clear we are currently living in a time when earthquake frequency has increased. It will be interesting to see if the immediate future maintains this trend.

Brother William Branham in the message the "Second Coming of the Lord" JEFF IN 04-17-57 speaks of the finger of God in the Oakland earthquake he experienced.

12 And Jesus begin to speak to them, "The time will come when there will not be stone left upon the other. You shall hear of wars and rumors of wars, pestilence, earthquakes in divers places." And the other day over in California, up in Oakland, when it was our privilege to be there in a meeting, and it was the first time that my wife had ever been in an earthquake. I was setting in the barber shop, and I... The room shook just a little. And the radio quickly announced, "An earthquake was on." Said, "They're looking for another one in about eight minutes." And I thought, "Oh, what if this is the last one?" I hurried from the barber shop, met my wife who was waiting on the street, walked into a little drugstore to get some little picture cards to send back to our

loved ones. And while we were there, one of the most mysterious, funny feelings that man could ever feel, the whole earth begin to rock. The bottles begin to fall from the shelf, the flues begin to fall off the building, and into the street, overrun, the people screaming and crying as the plaster fell from the walls. And the big buildings with thirty and forty stories, rocked together until the smoke or dust from the mortar went up like a great mushroom. And people begin to scream and run; I said, "That is the finger of Almighty God, saying, 'The handwriting's on the wall."

13 Jesus said, "When you hear of earthquakes in divers places." The earth split open down the highway for a long ways, about five foot, and went way down hundreds of feet in the earth. One place, the entire highway dropped in. And I thought as that split open, I could just almost see the finger of Almighty God, saying, "And there shall be earthquakes in divers places." While the day was going on, eight different earthquakes rocked that city. And beer joints stayed open, and drunks swarmed into the streets. And women walked the streets, half-dressed, and everything as if nothing had ever happened. People are so earthbound today till I don't know what it will take to shake this country. They just seem to be so unconcerned. They don't notice. And one man even made a remark, as I heard him with my own ears and, said, "Did you see what I did? I shook my fist. I am the superman." And I thought, "Such blasphemy."

Did Brother Branham initiate the Alaskan earthquake?In the message WHAT IS THE ATTRACTION ON THE MOUNTAIN. JEFF - IN 07-25-65 Eveningp49 What was it? I went westward. The very next day, standing there, a whirlwind came down and blasted the mountains out. Rocks cut the top of the trees off, about three or four feet above my head. I said, "Judgment is striking the west coast." About two days after that, the earthquake almost sunk Alaska. Middle East Update: ~Lebanon, Turkey and Iran~

Greetings once again in the name of our Lord and King, Jesus Christ.

5 March 2010

By now I'm sure that many of you have heard via the believers "prayer-vine" that we recently encountered yet another challenge in Lebanon. Due to being "flagged" by the Immigration Department, we were almost forced to leave the country on Tuesday. It began on Saturday when we were returning from ministry in Turkey. At immigration in the airport Rebekah's passport was seized and she was given only 72 hours to stay.

Thus, Monday and Tuesday were very hectic as we raced around and spent time in numerous Government offices trying to resolve the matter. We thank the Lord that Sister Rebekah's passport has been redeemed - we have it back. However, we are not out of the "woods" yet. We've gained a short reprieve while we now apply for Residency Status — which leads to another "challenge".

Every residency application requires a full scale and thorough investigation as to what is our purpose in Lebanon – what have we been doing; why we want to stay in Lebanon, etc. So you see, our continuancy won't be certain for another 2-3 weeks – until our application is approved.

To make matters even more interesting, headlines in the news reported the following;

<u>Hizbullah</u>: Every Lebanese and Arab Must Deal with Holders of Foreign Passports as Potential Spies

Security must be stepped up for all foreigners entering Lebanon as they could be secret agents like those who murdered a top Hamas official in Dubai, Hizbullah MP Nawwaf al-Moussawi said on Tuesday, March 2nd. "We must tighten foreign passport control at the airport and elsewhere in the country," Moussawi told AFP. "Every Lebanese and Arab must deal with holders of foreign passports as potential spies."

Please remember us in your prayers as we sincerely claim the promise that the "doors" the Lord has opened — "...no man can shut!"

We began the ministry in Turkey two weeks ago in Istanbul, the ruler Constantine's ancient capital known as Constantinople — but changed to its current name by the Muslims centuries later. Brother Ercu was on hand to receive us at the airport. We were thankful to have Brother Frank Prater and Brother Tony Roberts from Arkansas join us.

From Istanbul we traveled to Smyrna to meet with A. and his wife Y. Even before I could really get into sharing more of the Message, Brother A. shared with me how he was not associated with any denomination or group. He simply couldn't. He also said; "...if you ask pastors...they will tell you I am like a spiritual "miss-fit". An honest admission like that is often an indication of a "seed", so I was quick to share with him that he was not alone, but in good "company". Needless to say we had a



wonderful time in the Word. Brother A. was very receptive and soon realized that we had no other interest than sharing the Truth with him. How thankful I was to be able to leave with him messages of the Prophet translated into Turkish!

Four hours by bus from Smyrna we reached the city of Laodicea. The accuracy of prophecy was numbing as we stood at the entrance of the ruins of this once rich and prosperous city. Laodicea's "light" had indeed been totally extinguished. The only remnant of anything remotely Christian in this city was the historical fragments carved in stone. Nothing – not even Catholic or Orthodox remains in this city from previous ages.



How fitting it is that only now, in the days of the "Voice" to Laodicea are there only a few souls found in this region of ½ a million people. What interpretation can we apply to the prophecy that in the "evening time", in <u>Laodicea</u>...it shall be light again! Preaching the evening time message from the Word of God to these poor souls struggling to exist in Laodicea, was an exhilarating experience. We could feel the Holy Spirit's presence as a fulfillment of the very Word of God to where we were and what we were doing.

These connections (and more emails are being received) was made possible solely by having heard Brother Branham's message in Turkish on the radio. By God's grace we spent nearly twelve hours with A., his wife S. and her sister in the Word. They too rejoiced in hearing the Truth saying it was a great blessing, "...like a conference on the Bible...".



In addition to meeting A. and S. in Laodicea, we invited Brother S., an independent traveling minister who also heard the broadcast. Since he lives in the southern, Mediterranean region of Turkey, we invited him to Laodicea to spend time with us. (Pictured at left)

Though our time was relatively short, it was very rewarding and I believe fruitful. Before leaving we gave messages translated into Turkish to all. We now commit the "sowing" of the

Word of God to the Holy Spirit. Plans for follow up ministry are already being contemplated to help establish these hungry souls in the present day truth and so they can grow in faith and revelation.

In Istanbul we also met with Brother the Iranian brother who is keeping us informed of the situation concerning the believers in Iran. I received word from him since returning from Turkey that several more brothers were thankfully released in the last few days. Thus, only four brothers are still incarcerated. They are as follows;



We sincerely thank you for the faithful prayers for us and all those mentioned. It is by the power of prayer and your generous support that you provide that makes our work here in the Middle East and in Turkey possible.

This is a prayer request as I return to Indonesia, Myanmar (Burma), and Vietnam around the middle of April. We have a contact in Myanmar by the name of Sawko Yethan. We know him as "Brother Chris". When I emailed him to accept his invitation, he told me of his plans to hold three days worth of "Ministers' Meetings" at his compound – involving around two hundred people.

He can feed them for USD\$2-00 per person, per day. That's not five star cuisine, but it will keep them alive! Multiplied out, that comes to USD\$1,200-00 for the two hundred people for those three days. The economy in Myanmar is non-existent and he's asked that I cover those costs.

I have paid my tickets, and have sufficient funds to cover accommodation, food, insurance, visas etc.. for myself, but this additional cost is stretching the budget a bit – yet I see it as a very worthy cause, and in myself would like to try and make it happen.

I understand most of you have missionary-type programs that you're already committed to. I certainly have no desire to interfere with those. However if you had some "discretionary dollars" you would like to see go to a good cause, I would do my best to see they're well spent. Funds would be channelled through our church missionary account: Rapturing Grace Tabernacle — Missions. Cheques can be made out to that name and posted to: 45 Collingwood Street, ELTHAM, 4322. I will be personally accountable for the money and report back fully to any contributors on my return.

Regardless of whether you're able to contribute financially, I'd truly appreciate your prayer support over those days April 15th to May 7th.



Fiji Trip Report

From January 28th, 2010, I saw our Lord Jesus moving by His Spirit for 15 days. More than 60 people fully surrendered their heart to Jesus, and I saw at least 20 healed by the power of God.



The 2nd day, while I was speaking on a Christian radio station, a man rang asking me to call him when I finished. He had just returned home, tuned into the radio station, and God told him, "get that man to pray for you, and you won't need those crutches anymore." He sent a taxi for me, and when I left his home, he was walking without crutches. Brother Reddy [left] was the first of 4 people who were able to walk unassisted after prayer.

The 3rd day six people, at a bus stop, totally surrendered their hearts to the Lord, while I was waiting for the bus. There were 14 that gave their heart to Jesus that day. I would not have met any of these, if I had been there at the correct time to catch the bus.

In one village, I visited 4 homes, and everyone (except children) gave their hearts to Jesus, and all the sick were healed. One lady [below left] had broken her

> left leg just above the ankle, 2 years ago, and it would not heal. Firstly, she totally surrendered her heart to Jesus, then she walked without pain and moved her foot for the first time in 2 years.

> These are just three of the testimonies that occurred in these meetings. There were others: a lady who was almost blind, who could only see 2 inches in front of her. After the prayer of faith in our Lord Jesus' Name, she saw me standing ten feet away.





There was a boy in the same village, who had been dropped as a baby in hospital. This had left him crippled and his back twisted. He was now about seven years old. I previously saw him drag himself through the village to his home. His knees were in a bad way, but after prayer, we lifted Amani, [right] and his legs dropped straight. He then straightened his feet that were twisted about 30 degrees from

During the trip, 2 ministers fully surrendered their heart to Jesus Christ. They had not given all their heart to the Lord before.

The constant theme was that full surrender brings Christ into the heart, Anything short of this may bring blessings and an outward presence of God, but not a "born again" experience. The people really related to the statement, "Jesus will not share your heart with the devil."

Pt 5. Brother Freddy Esau

The hour that we are living in! What a time we are living in as believers. This time of gloom and



darkness, Brother, I would let you know, the Light of God is shining through into the lives of His people. Oh, I would encourage you this morning, Brothers, that no matter what situation you are in this morning, you can this morning.

switch your position. You can this morning, walk out of that situation and say 'I am not any more going to sit here just like the lepers who were sitting outside the city.'

Brother, they were saying, 'Man, if we sit here to die, and if we go into the city, we are also going to die.' But they said, 'I'd rather die with a full belly than to die with an empty belly.' Hallelujah! And they went into the city and God had already done something in the city. Hallelujah! You can walk out. Hallelujah! Can you say, 'devil, you have had me long enough?' You can say, devil, you have had me bogged down enough, but I'm coming out this morning. I'm not going to allow you to dictate to me, because God has already told me He's going to meet me on the other side.

When Jesus told His disciples in the Book of Mark, after He had preached the Word, 'Take the boat and you go over and I'll meet you over on the other side.' So He already said that, Brother. They had a good time of revival, seeing what God was doing. 'Get in the boat'. The Bible says that Jesus Christ went off secretly. They got into the boat. Hallelujah! And as the Brothers talked of the goodness of The Lord and having a revival time, hallelujah! – the devil was watching them. 'Ahah – Ahah, He's not with them now. Let us go on and attack him. Brother, the Bible said that the storm woke up and they were hardened fishermen.

These men knew and here they were, Brothers, caught in the midst of the storm. They forgot all that He said. They forgot all the good times that they had. That's what the enemy does. He causes you amnesia. He causes you to forget the goodness of the Lord. Causes you to forget He's just healed you of diabetes and now He has healed you of this disease and that disease. And now the enemy, Brother. And you are in church and you've just testified, 'My God is good.' You've just testified,

'He's my healer.' You've just testified Brother, 'He's my keeper. He's paid my mortgage.' You've just testified, 'I filled up my car', and Brother, you didn't walk to the church, nor walked your way home. Hallelujah!

Something happened. You see, it was the enemy. Whatever you say he's going to attack you on. Whatever you say. Hallelujah! You've got to prove to him everything you say is a reality to you. It's easy to question Scriptures. It's easy to say, 'the joy of the Lord is my strength.' It's easy to say, Brothers, Hallelujah, The Lord inhabits the praises of His people. It's easy to say those quotes. But Brother, let me tell you, He's going to cause darkness to come. He's going to cause things to happen – for one purpose – to prove what you have just said. He's proving me on what I preach.

That's why believers are preaching this morning. He could say, 'that enemy's giving me a hard time. I'm not going to stand this morning and preach'. The enemy says, 'I tried you on everything that you say.' And here were the disciples on their way to the other side. Now God has already told them, 'I'll meet you the other side.' Already. And Brother, in the midst of the ocean the waves came and everything that they were just talking about, they forgot and they started screaming out. You see, we allow the enemy and allow the circumstances to dictate to us. It dictates to us. It tells me how I must react.

And Jesus came walking on the water. Is it you, Lord? I tell you church, this is where you are at right now and this is where the enemy is attacking God's people. But I want to let you know this morning church, you can walk out this morning.

A neighbour walked past of old and he saw this dog sitting on the porch and this dog was fooling and moaning and crying and turning around and squibbling and moaning and crying. And the neighbour asked, 'What's wrong with your dog?' And the guy said, 'Oh he's sitting on a nail.' And the neighbour asked, 'Why doesn't he get off that nail?' Maybe the pain is not enough. Maybe that's the reason he's still sitting, because the pain is not enough. We find ourselves in situations that we are squirming and moaning and groaning, sitting on the nail. But we don't want to lift ourselves. But God, this morning, is offering you the way out. Switch positions men! There's something better!
