TESTIMONY OF HEALING

Simple Faith.

In September and October of 2016, we had some ministers meetings over a period of 2 weeks in Goroka in Papua New Guinea.

Even though the meetings were mainly for ministers, any brethren that wanted to attend could.



One of the pastors (Bro' Nicolas Angae) brought his teenage daughter to be prayed for. She had been afflicted by a paralysis from her waist down and had become incapable of walking. All the medical experts had no idea as to the cause of her problem so nothing could be done for her. She had to be carried everywhere by her sister and mother and father and as you can see in the photo provided, she could only sit in a chair after being placed in it.

Nearing the end of the meetings it was arranged for her to be carried to the front of the church where all the brothers would pray for her. It was told to her that the Lord could do one of two things. He could either do a miracle and she could get up immediately and walk away, or He would heal her over a period of time.

She was told that the Lord was the High priest of her profession or confession. That in the same way as the Lord created the heaven and the earth, the creation came around those words He spoke. So if she spoke that she was healed, the healing would materialize around her confession. She understood this principle of God.

After she was prayed for she still could not stand up, so she knew that over a period of time upon her continued confession. Even though she was a sixteen year old, there was something about this young sister that was very faithful to the word of God. After the meetings she was taken back home still unable to walk.

At Christmas time Bro' Nicolas rang me to wish me a Merry Christmas and a happy new year. He then told me about his daughter (Sister Rachel) that had been prayed for. She was now walking with the assistance of walking sticks and she was believing for a complete restoration. Again she was encouraged to keep confessing her healing so that she could walk normally again.

Last week (20 - 2 - 2017), Bro' Nicolas rang me to say that his daughter was now walking unassisted and was back at school and is able to cook and wash clothes like normal again. The doctors cannot fathom what has happened to her.

Bro Nicholas' Testimony (Father of Racheal)

LAST year June 2016 Rachel felt sick. We took her to Kerowagi rural health center.She was hospitalized for 3 weeks. From there she was transfered to Kundiawa general hospital. She was completely paralized from head to toe. We stayed in the hospital for two months. The doctors there couldn't identify the sickness or the cause. They told me to just take her back home fearing that she might contract another sickness from other patients so we took Racheal home. However, she still didn't walk.

At the recent Goroka message meetings we decided to take Racheal along. At the meeting Racheal was prayed for. From then on Racheal began to move her limps and hands and started walking along a rail we fixed in front of our home She left the rail so we gave her a crutch for support eventually she left the crutch and now she is back in school doing grade seven in the same school I am teaching in. Noah's Ark.

Location of Noah's Ark. Coordinates of one end of this object. N 39.26.475 E 44.14.108

Many expeditions have attempted to locate Noah's Ark, including a number that claimed they found it, but have been shown to be frauds. The Bible said... "And the ark rested in the seventh month, on the seventeenth day of the month, upon the mountains of Ararat." Genesis 8:4. Verse 5 continues, "And the waters decreased continually until the tenth month: in the tenth month, on the first day of the month, were the tops of the mountains seen." At the time the Ark came to rest, Mt Ararat was not the volcano it is today. The reason for this statement is that the mountains were not visible until 2 and a half months later, but from the Ark's resting place today, Mt Ararat, standing 16945ft above sea level, can be clearly seen. From space Mt Ararat is clearly more recent than the mountains it is built on. i.e. The surrounding mountains are sedimentary, Mt Ararat is volcanic. The Bible did not say the Ark rested on Mt Ararat, but on the mountains of that area. The site of the Ark's resting place is about 30km south of Mt Ararat, near the border of Turkey and Iran, and not far from a village called Güngören. This is recognized by the Turkish government as the Ark site, and there is road signs indicating this. (Nuh's Ark). Nuh is the Chaldean (Babylonian) name for Noah.

Magnetic tests.

A magnetometer is a device that measures the Earth's magnetic field. (It is normally used to locate submarines under water, where the metal hull, distorts the magnetic field slightly, allowing location to occur.) Magnetometer tests carried out on the area around the Ark site, show distortions, indicating that there is metal present.

Radar testing.

These tests indicate when changes in density occur. This shows a regular pattern, of parallel lines, and cross lines, such as what might be expected from timber bulkheads and beams of a boat-like structure.

Core sample tests.

Some core samples have shown the presence of fossilized timbers, parts of deer antler, along with hairs that have been identified as belonging to a cat, (Leopard) which is not a native of the area. There is also fossilized nails that are square in shape. It is thought these are responsible for the magnetometer readings obtained.

Photographic tests.

Comparisons have been made of aerial photographs taken on different expeditions. These indicate that the surrounding land has slid down the hill. The Ark section in these photographs, however, has not moved, and is also becoming more exposed. The bulk and size of the structure is keeping it firmly in position.

Physical tests.

The length of the Ark is 515ft 6in. The size of Noah's Ark as mentioned in the Bible, Genesis 6:15, *And this is the fashion which thou shalt make it of: The length of the ark shall be three hundred cubits, the breadth of it fifty cubits, and the height of it thirty cubits.* This size is exactly correct, if the Royal Egyptian cubit (524mm) is used, to calculate the length.

Other Clues.

Stabilization - Anchor stones.

Not far from the Ark's resting place there are a number of stones, in a reasonably straight line. These are described as anchor stones. An anchor stone is a large stone, wide in one direction, narrow in another, with a hole at the top, allowing it to be attached to ropes. A number of these would stabilize the vessel, in the huge swells that might be expected. They are many feet in height (8 or more), much bigger than anchor stones that are normally found. These are also many miles (75ml or more) from the nearest sea or ocean. Noah would have released these progressively, to allow the Ark to ride higher in the water, before it came to a rest.
